



Note: *Aerosol Generating Medical Procedure (AGMP) is any procedure that may induce production of aerosols of various sizes, including droplet nuclei.

AGMPs considered high risk for AIIR placement include: Bronchoscopy, Continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) or bilevel positive airway pressure (BIPAP); Intubation and extubation procedures; CPR with bag valve, Optiflow

AGMPs considered lower risk-AIIR if available, otherwise private room with hard walls and closed door: Nebulized therapy, NP aspirates, washes and scoping, open airway suctioning, sputum induction.
