USS NOMAD NCC-72382-A Regulations

Code of Conduct:

- 1. Crew must wear a uniform at all meetings. At away missions, the uniform is optional but rank badges and comm badges are required.
 - a. The USS Nomad allows members to choose the Star Trek Uniform of any era.
 - b. The Nomad recognizes the Starfeet Canada badge (Appendix 'A) as the official comm badge, but again allows members to choose badge of their liking.
- 2. All members must conduct themselves appropriately. Respect must be shown to fellow crewmates and commanding officers. Without going into do's and don'ts it is expected people joining this club understand what is appropriate and right and wrong.
 - a. Any complaints of behaviour or language must be taken to the Executive Officer.
 - b. If a serious violation has occurred and the C/O and XO agree, a member may be removed from the chapter.
- 3. Ranks are to be respected and acknowledged during meetings and Away missions. We are "LARP" Trek and need to behave accordingly or we could be any club. Other interactions are casual as ranks have no "real life" authority.
- **4.** All members regardless if crew person, technician, officer or Chief, are expected to act in a professional manner. You are now a representative of the USS Nomad. Please be respectful with other organizations.
- 5. Please be on time to meetings and events. Remember if your not early, you are late.
- **6.** We are here to have a good time and have fun.

Promotions:

- 1. Promotions are handed out throughout the year. They are based on the discretion of the Executive Officer and Commanding Officer.
- 2. Promotions are earned not simply handed out. Some of the expectations are:
 - a. Helping Crew members
 - b. Helping charities
 - c. Participation in Meetings and events
 - d. Volunteer Work outside of club
 - e. Positive reflection of the club
 - f. Recruiting new members
- 3. A department Head is responsible for bring a promotion to the Executive Officer.

 Recommendation is forwarded to the Chapter C/O for final approval.
- 4. At this time, The USS Nomad NCC -72382 is not affiliated to a main organization. The highest rank that can be obtained is that of Commander.
 - a. If the Nomad joins a group such as Task force 31/BravoFleet, Starfleet (Not SFI-appendix B), then the rank system of that organization supersedes that of the Nomad Regulations.

Missions:

- 1. At all away missions and events, it is expected the member wear their uniform. If not available please wear comm badge and rank pins on a long sleeve t-shirt of departmental colour.
- 2. Please participate in the event. If we are not participating as a group, it may be perceived our group is not strong and engaged.
- 3. If help is required at an event, please do so.
- **4.** If you require the following, please ask in advance:
 - **a.** A ride to the event
 - **b.** To leave early
 - c. To arrive late
 - d. To not wear uniform
 - e. To not participate in some form. We will be accommodating if you need to call in.
- 5. Suggest and research away missions. Put them forward at meetings for group approval.

Ranks:

Commodore and higher: Available only to the Commanding Officer

Captain: Member with 10 years or more or the Commanding Officer of the Chapter

Commander: Highest Rank Available on the Nomad
