2025-2026 Season

- The season will run:
 - Winter: October - January
 - Spring: February - April
 - Summer: May - July
- First practice will be October 1st
 - 4:30-5:15pm
- See attached calendar for performances and competitions. Performances at hockey games and other events TBD.

Performance Team Requirements

- Winter/Spring Ice Diamonds
 - **Completed** Basic 4 Skills (Learn to Skate)
 - **Must** hold at least a Friends of MVSC membership
 - **Required** to be registered in a Learn To Skate class and/or taking private lessons
- Summer Session Ice Diamonds
 - **Passed** minimum of Preliminary Skating Skills test
 - **Must** hold a Full MVSC membership (either Introductory or Full)
 - **Required** to sign up for and/or maintain private lessons to improve skating techniques and form
- Everyone
 - Attend team practices on Wednesdays at the Greeley Ice Haus
 - Participate in a **minimum of ONE** fundraising events
 - Any skater over the age of 18 will be **required** to be SafeSkate compliant
 - Costumes will be purchased by MVSC and will be returned at the end of the session (unless you are continuing into the next session). **HOWEVER**, should you damage or lose it, you will be responsible for the replacement.
- Communication regarding practices, performances and competitions will be done through an app called BAND. All team members and/or parents will be required to download the app and check it on a regular basis to ensure everyone receives all needed communications.

Attendance Policy and Communication

Attendance is **CRUCIAL** for a successful team! One skater failing to show up for practice affects the entire team. Absent skaters result in non-productive practices due to coaches having to re-choreograph routines and it is difficult for a team to gracefully change their routine when someone doesn't show up for practice or performances. Missing a team

member during practices or performances can also create safety issues for the team when having to change routines to accommodate the absent skater.

- Each skater is permitted 2 “excused absences” for family obligations & travel flexibility. For any other absence to be considered “excused”, it must be due to emergencies, illness or mandatory school obligations. Any absences must be communicated to the Performance Chair and coach as far in advance as possible. With the exception of illness and emergencies, absences **MUST** be communicated at least **24 HOURS PRIOR TO** the start of practice.
- Unexcused absences **WILL NOT** be tolerated.
- Excessive absences (even if excused) will result in a review from the committee and may result in removal from the team.
- Should a skater miss practice and miss choreography changes, it will be the responsibility of the skater to work with their teammates to learn the routine. Coaches will NOT repeatedly re-teach the same choreography.
- **All performances are required.** If a skater will not be able to make one of the performances this **MUST** be communicated to the Performance Chair and coach **at least 2 weeks prior to** the performance.

Fee Schedule

- Registration will open August 1, 2025 and close September 30, 2025
- Tuition: **\$375/session** - can be paid in full or monthly installments
 - Monthly installments will be automatically charged to the card on file on the first of each month.
 - Failure to make each payment by the 7th of each month will result in skater being “benched” until payment is received
