Performance Team Requirements

- Jr Ice Diamonds
 - o Completed Basic 4 Skills (Learn to Skate)
 - Must hold at least a Friends of MVSC membership
 - Required to be registered in a Learn To Skate class and/or taking private lessons
- Sr Ice Diamonds
 - o **Passed** minimum of Preliminary Skating Skills test
 - o Must hold a Full MVSC membership (either Introductory or Full)
 - o **Required** to sign up for and/or maintain private lessons to improve skating techniques and form
- Everyone
 - Attend team practices on Wednesdays at the Greeley Ice Haus. Junior Ice Diamonds will practice
 4:45-5:15 pm and Sr Ice Diamonds will practice
 4:15-5:15 pm.
 - Purchase at least one costume for performances.
 - o Participate in a *minimum* of **TWO** fundraising events
 - Any skater over the age of 18 will be required to be SafeSkate compliant
- Communication regarding practices, performances and competitions will be done though an app called BAND.
 All team members and/or parents will be required to download the app and check it on a regular basis to ensure everyone receives all needed communications.

Attendance Policy and Communication

Attendance is **CRUCIAL** for a successful team! One skater failing to show up for practice affects the entire team. Absent skaters result in non-productive practices due to coaches having to re-choreograph routines and it is difficult for a team to gracefully change their routine when someone doesn't show up for practice or performances. Missing a team member during practices or performances can also create safety issues for the team when having to change routines to accommodate the absent skater.

- This year, the focus of the performance team will be competitions. As a result, we will be learning one primary
 routine with the potential for a second routine for combined Jr and Sr team performances. These routines will
 be learned in the first six weeks of the season. NO ABSENCES ARE ALLOWED DURING THIS TIME!!
- Each skater is permitted 2 "excused absences" for family obligations & travel flexibility. For any other absence to
 be considered "excused", it must be due to emergencies, illness or mandatory school obligations. Any absences
 must be communicated to the Performance Chair and coach as far in advance as possible. With the exception of
 illness and emergencies, absences MUST be communicated at least 24 HOURS PRIOR TO the start of practice.
- Unexcused absences WILL NOT be tolerated.
- Excessive absences (even if excused) will result in a review from the committee and may result in removal from the team.
- Should a skater miss practice and miss choreography changes, it will be the responsibility of the skater to work with their teammates to learn the routine. Coaches will NOT repeatedly re-teach the same choreography.
- <u>All performances are required.</u> If a skater will not be able to make one of the performances this **MUST** be communicated to the Performance Chair and coach at least 2 weeks prior to the performance.
