## **GENERAL SHOW INFORMATION:**

This event is sanctioned by U.S. Figure Skating Association & hosted by the Mountain View Skating Club (MVSC).

## **SHOW ELIGIBILITY AND ROLES:**

There are various parts that individuals can enroll in for the Spring Showcase. Each skater is limited to two (2) performances. These can be comprised of solos, duets, or small ensembles. Solos, duets, and ensembles will be arranged by each skater/group. Soloist, Duets, and Ensembles are required to have a certified private coach providing lessons for choreography of each performance the skater(s) perform(s) in.

Below is a definition of each role skaters are eligible for:

- **SOLOS** Soloist must be a current member of MVSC. Soloists are required to have a certified private coach provide lessons and choreography for each performance the skater performs in.
- **DUETS** / **ENSEMBLE** Duets/Ensembles will be decided between the skaters. If you/your skater is interested in a duet/ensemble and cannot find a partner(s), please reach out to Holli at holli@mountainviewskatingclub.org for help. **This does not guarantee you will be matched with a partner**.
- **GUEST SKATERS** Guest skaters are non-MVSC skaters that have a current USFSA membership, either through the Learn to Skate program or another club. Can participate in up to two (2) performances, either solo/duet/ensemble. Should schedule/time conflicts arise, MVSC members will receive primary consideration, followed by guest skaters from Greeley Ice Haus, and lastly skaters from other clubs.

## SHOW COMMITMENT, PRACTICE SCHEDULE, AND IMPORTANT DATES:

For the Spring Showcase to be successful, skaters must commit to the scheduled dates below for show practices, dress rehearsals, and show date(s). We understand that while scheduling conflicts do arise, they should be kept at a minimum. Skater absences MUST be communicated to the MVSC Show Director <u>24 hours in advance if possible</u>. Spring Showcase registration deadline is **April 1st. Schedule of skate orders will be released via email by April 19th.**

#### REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

**Guest Skaters (Solo / Duet / Ensemble),** if accepted by the Show Director and Committee, will pay a fee of \$50 for first routine and \$35 for second routine. Payment is due at time of registration. Guest skaters are required to have a certified private coach provide lessons and choreography for every performance they perform in. Guest skaters are also required to provide their own costume(s) for the showcase.

MVSC Member (Solo / Duet / Ensemble) participation fee is \$30 for the first performance and \$15 for the

second. Payment is due at time of registration. Solo / Duet / Ensemble participants must also provide certified private coaching for lessons and choreography for each performance in the showcase. Costume(s) provided by the skater.

Show registration and fees will be conducted through MVSC's website.

There are no refunds of show fees unless we cut performance(s) due to time constraints.

## **COSTUMES:**

Skaters will need to work with their coach to dress in an appropriate show costume related to their song choice(s).

## **MUSIC:**

Skaters will be responsible for their own music. If skaters in a duet/trio are in different levels, please use the lowest level skater to determine music length. The following music lengths will be implemented:

### **DRESS REHEARSALS:**

There will be no dress rehearsal for this showcase. Performers are expected to know their schedule and be ready to take the ice during their allotted time.

## **SHOW DAY:**

The skaters, chaperones, and volunteers must arrive no later than one (1) hour prior to show time. All skaters will be assigned to a locker room with their designated groups/acts. A 15 minute warmup is scheduled for 2:00 - 2:15pm.

Parents and other family members **WILL NOT** be allowed to access the locker room area during the performances. Only SkateSafe qualified chaperones will accompany the children at all times in the locker rooms and restrooms. Skaters are expected to be respectful at all times and to follow the rules of the group chaperones. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. The MVSC board will review if inappropriate behavior by skaters will warrant them being removed from the current show and/or subsequent shows in the future. **ABSOLUTELY NO CELL PHONES WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE OUT IN A LOCKER ROOM. PICTURES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE TAKEN IN LOCKER ROOMS.**
