Synchro Team Requirements

- Freeskate/Aspire Level Skaters
 - Hold at least an MVSC Aspire or Ice Haus Academy Aspire membership
- Pre-Juvenile/Open Juvenile Team
 - Hold a Full MVSC membership
 - Passed a minimum of Preliminary Skating Skills test
- Everyone
 - Skaters must register for the synchronized skating class through Greeley Ice Haus for the duration of the synchro season. This will be the designated practice time.
 - Must be in private lessons and continue throughout the season the synchro class is to perfect the synchro elements, not teach progressive skating skills
 - Must be willing to attend each competition/performance larger competitions start during the week and there could be a chance we would be scheduled during a weekday
 - Purchase at least one costume for performances.

Attendance Policy and Communication

Attendance is CRUCIAL for a successful team! Skaters cannot gracefully change their routine on the fly because someone does not show up to a competition, nor does it facilitate a productive practice when the coach has to re-choreograph routines every week because people are absent.

- Each skater is permitted 2 "excused absences" to allow for illness & travel flexibility. Excused absences are
 defined as having been communicated to the Coach or MVSC Rep PRIOR TO the start of practice.
- Unexcused absences WILL NOT be tolerated. Excessive absences (even if excused) will result in a review from the
 committee and will result in penalties UP TO being removed from the team.
- Should a skater miss practice and miss choreography changes, it will be the responsibility of the skater to work with their teammates to learn the routine. Coaches will NOT repeatedly re-teach the same choreography.
