- This application must be completed and returned postmarked by "mail only" to
 <u>Anita Higginbotham, 214 Kerry Dr., Crossett, AR 71635 by Fri, April 11, 2025</u>.
 Applications will <u>only be accepted by mail</u>. Applications received postmarked after April 11, 2025 or later <u>will not</u> be considered. Applications will not be accepted in person by any scholarship committee member. You must apply to be eligible.
- 2. There will be NO interview portion of the scholarship process. Please be as thorough and concise as possible in your application materials. In the written portion about goals, ambitions, and career goals--be as complete and specific as possible since there will be no opportunities for questions and answers.
- 3. Copies of official ACT scores and high school transcripts MUST be included in the application. Applications which do not include official documentation of ACT scores and high school transcripts will not be considered.
- 4. <u>AHSRA performance based scholarships</u> will be awarded depending on availability of funds in scholarship fund for that year.
- 5. A brief but concise essay is expected to provide information in regard to school activities, other organization activities, and leadership activities. The essay should also describe your personal goals, ambitions, and career goals that you have at this time.
- 6. The application must include two (2) recommendations from individuals other than family members.
- 7. An AHSRA scholarship committee score sheet is being provided to you so that you can fully understand the point and scoring method. Those with the highest score will be voted on by the scholarship committee then recommended to the AHSRA Board of Directors for final approval.
- 8. The AHSRA scholarship committee will meet and select scholarship recipients after the deadline. The scholarship recipients will be announced and notified at that time.
