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## 1. INTRODUCTION

Since centres have begun to recruit cases and controls, periodic summaries of data collection are being obtained. This document provides the data collected from Mobi-kids centres in May 2011.

### 1.1. Summary of data (May 2011)

The number of cases and controls who have been identified, interviewed and refused to participate by centre as of May 2011, is provided in a table in the Annex.


At this time, eight of the fourteen countries have not begun data collection. One of these countries, New Zealand, has not received funding to begin the steps necessary to start subject recruitment. Three of the other countries, Canada, Japan, and India recently received funding so are in the process of obtaining ethics approval and providing mobile phone information for the database. The remaining four countries, Australia, France, Taiwan and the Netherlands are expected to begin subject recruitment in the next month.

For the six countries who have recruited subjects, a total of 82 cases have been identified with 57 interviewed and 5 refusals, and a total of 89 controls identified with 60 interviewed and 7 refusals.

All the subjects interviewed to date have been collected with the paper version of the questionnaires. When the electronic application for recording the interview data is in use, standard and periodic data downloads will be provided to CREAL for quality control and to inform the exposure assessment plan. Some data was requested for review and discussion at the most recent full study group meeting.

## 2. CONCLUSION


Data collection is underway in several centres and will be moving forward in the centres who have received funding (all countries dependent on receiving funding are outside the EU). A future periodic summary will be submitted.
