
Ten riders arrived at the start line at 7 A.M. Six had non specific plans to ride to Wardell or Broadwater and the remaining four Simon, Gavin, Richard and Dave chose to ride the club recommended route which was a lot longer. This route followed Ballina cutting, Ellis Road, Cemetery Road, Rous Road and a descent down Devils Elbow, Tucki Road over two more ridges to the Bora Ring, Wardell Road, Broadwater Road and Blackwall Drive to Wardell with return along River Road.



Total distance was just over 80 km with lots of climbs. We were fortunate to have a tailwind from Tucki Road to Ballina for the most part. The scenery along Wyrallah Road was stimulating because

the road follows a lot of high ground looking down on the flood plain to the south. Ellis Road is also very scenic. The big surprise was the good to excellent road surface over most of the route. We returned to the Proper Cafe at 10:15 where the other riders were just finishing coffee.


