Unfortunately Marc and Hayley missed a left-hand turn and got lost, so they effectively did not finish the ride circuit.

Simon done a marvellous time, over the 12.6 kilometre circuit, of 21 minutes and 57 seconds; averaging at 34.44 kph. Second best time was Mark Downey, just short of 33 kph. Mike Hardy done a great job getting third best time.

It was good to see Simon, Mark, Gavin, and Richard come to the training ride with time-trial bikes and helmets. It's always interesting to see these speed-machines and headgear. Simon's homemade aerodynamic helmet cover was a surprising sight to behold. Not only did it show inventive initiative but the club's sponsors as well. Good show, Simon.




