Bruce Syme was our timekeeper. Marc Mears and Michael Hardy were the only two riders that turned up for the time trial training ride. It has been the talk amongst us as to who was the Top Dog of our regular local group of riders – Michael or Marc?

Well, synchronicity has brought the two here today to test these two closely matched cyclists. Both Marc and Michael over the past few months have improved their cycling power quite noticeably. Some of us where already wondering, three weeks ago, how the two would compare on their first time trial training ride. But unfortunately Marc was uncertain about the ride route and got lost around Wardell. So this mishap had muted the question. But today has become an isolated rematch.

As you can see from the recorded times, for the 12.6 km circuit, that Marc was 12 seconds faster than Michael. Both were fairly closely matched. I can easily imagine the two, from now on, will be looking at each other just as closely too.

We don't officially know how Marc performed in comparison to his last time trial. However Michael comparison shows an improvement in time by ten seconds.




