After a rest at Wardell we returned via the ferry arriving in Ballina just before 11AM. Amazingly, even though the wind was largely a crosswind, we did get some assistance from it on the bulk of the trip home. Friday Report CRY WOLF - Peter

Before the 7AM start, someone cried "WET" (wolf), and straight away everything fell apart. Gavin and John arrived for the start, but thought nobody else will turn up, so they left several minutes early. I turned up at 6:56AM and waited till 7AM before heading off on my own. Tom was running late and he turned up at 7:01AM. So, four riders, in three different time frames, rode to Wardell and back. And the crazy thing was, non of use got a drop of rain. The roads from Fishery Creek Bridge to Wardell and back was dry as a bone.

I can only account for my own ride. The weather was cool and sunny. It was almost perfect except for some southerly headwind to Wardell. The return trip via River Drive was easier and a joy to cruise along almost effortlessly at 33 kph.

Fifty percent of the time the 'Coffee at 8AM' is in error. That is, it is not raining or the roads too wet nor windy for a ride. Even the Bureau of Meteorology's (BOM) weather predictions have a higher success rate than the wolf crier. What I am saying is, check the BOM weather reports and if you think it's worth a chance to ride, then ride. There is a good chance you won't be alone... Then again, some need others to make all the decisions for them.


