

# Educational tours



## Pre-School & Lower Elementary

Group size up to 25: \$5/person, over 25: \$3/person

Take a hay ride to the apple orchard where you will learn about how the trees and the fruit grow and you'll get to pick an apple to enjoy. We'll make apple cider\* and let you have a taste. *(approximately 45 minutes)*

## Upper Elementary

Group size up to 25: \$5/person, over 25: \$3/person

In addition to your orchard tour, we'll make apple cider\* and let you have a taste. On this tour, we will share about what the trees are doing throughout the seasons and how we manage them. *(approximately 1 hour)*

## Middle School

Group size up to 25: \$5/person, over 25: \$3/person

Students will have an orchard tour, make cider\* and learn about orchard management and tree health. They will have hands-on opportunities to identify pest/disease evidence. *(approximately 1 hour)*

## High School

Group size up to 25: \$6/person, over 25: \$4/person

In the Fall, students will learn about orchard management including Integrated Pest Management, which is the system we use to monitor orchard conditions and make management decisions. Students will have hands-on opportunities to identify pests/disease and their consequences in the orchard. We invite students to return in the late Winter or early Spring for a course on tree maintenance where the hands-on activity will be proper pruning techniques. *(approximately 1 – 1 1/2 hours)*

*\*please note: cider making depends on availability of cider apples*
