Code of Conduct for Female Athletes in Flag Football (KHAOS)

Academic Standards

GPA Requirement:

A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required to participate in games and tournaments. Athletes must maintain this standard throughout the season and provide regular academic updates.

Commitment & Attendance

Practice & Games:

Athletes must attend all practices and games unless previously excused by the coach. Consistent attendance and punctuality are mandatory.

If a player misses 5 out of 12 practices in that month without a valid excuse, they will be dismissed from the team.

Travel:

Commitment to traveling out of state for tournaments is required. Players must Plan accordingly to ensure they can participate in all scheduled events.

Financial Responsibility

Fees:

Tournament fees are required from every player. Fees must be paid on time according to the agreed-upon schedule. 100 by the first, the latest to turn in tournament fees is the 15th

Fundraising:

Athletes or their parents (if under working age) are responsible for participating in fundraising efforts to support the team. Those who prefer to pay the full amount directly may do so.

Every athlete is required to order a full travel set, which includes the following:

Team Structure

Team Mom:

Each team will have 2 designated Team Moms to assist with coordination, communication, and support for players and parents. The Team Mom will serve as a liaison between the coaching staff and families.

Behavioral Expectations

Sportsmanship:

Athletes are expected to display good sportsmanship on and off the field, respecting teammates, opponents, referees, and coaches.

Conduct:

Any form of bullying, harassment, or unsportsmanlike conduct is strictly prohibited and may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or dismissal from the team.

Social Media:

Athletes must use social media responsibly, refraining from posting content that could harm the team's reputation or offend others.

Health & Safety

Injury Reporting:

Athletes must promptly report any injuries to the coaching staff to ensure proper care and avoid further harm.

Hydration & Nutrition:

Players are encouraged to maintain proper hydration and nutrition to support their athletic performance and overall health.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

Support:

Parents/guardians are expected to support their athletes by attending games, assisting with fundraising, and adhering to the team's code of conduct.

Communication:

Open communication with coaches and team management is encouraged to address any concerns or issues promptly.

Disciplinary Actions

Warnings:

Minor infractions will receive a verbal or written warning.

Suspensions:

Repeated or serious violations may result in suspension from games or practices.

Dismissal:

Severe or continued violations can lead to dismissal from the team.
