Perhaps there is something else you would like to do that we can develop into a group? Volunteering is an excellent way to get out and about, meet people and find out what is going on in the village. If you are willing to volunteer, then please contact us. We would be very happy to support you in attending your first volunteering session or introduce you to the leader of the group prior to the session so you will know someone there.

What would you like to see the community raise funds for? e.g., Library, Eton Wick in Bloom (planters, hanging baskets, beds by Bell Lane shops etc), Youth Club equipment, Speed Indicator Device (digital road sign that shows how fast someone is driving into the village), or is there something else you feel you would like to fundraise for that would be a benefit to Eton Wick?



Are you aware that we are trying to start a Neighbourhood Watch group in the village? We have a village coordinator but need individual street volunteers to cascade information to residents on their street and keep them updated. This can be done on a WhatsApp or email group and won't be a great deal of work. Its about being the 'eyes & ears' of the community for any criminal or suspicious behaviour and ensuring any vulnerable people in our community are supported. If you are willing to be a street coordinator, then please let us know your name and contact details.
