

For me, the following is the world's biggest example of how helpfulness is infinitely more profitable than selfishness:

In **WWII**, we in the U.S., a help-sharing representative democracy, helped the whole world by beating back aggressive, selfish, profiteering, help-hoarding, world-poisoning authoritarianism. That massive help to the world from us in the U.S. built the U.S. economy into the world's richest, to lead the world all major ways, with just 5.9% of its people.

Unfortunately, we in the U.S. are now ceding much of that world-leading role to authoritarian-led China, which has 3x more people than the U.S.— While help-sharing representative democracies are 20% more profitable per year, per capita GDP, than such authoritarian states; which, compounded = 3700% more ea. 20 years, 146,000% more ea. 40 years. So why are we ceding our leadership role? Our U.S. media has made our politics incredibly selfish on all sides & thus value-and-economy-poisoning. Fixing that problem is a big goal of this project.
