



HOW PISGAH HOME BEGAN ITS MINISTRY AND BECAME ECHO HOME

(continued from May Issue)

We take God at His word, and stand upon Phil. 4:19

As the work grew, the mission was moved to larger quarters.

It is hard to realize that the Spring Street Mission with the clean, quiet, holy Christian atmosphere was once the vilest dens of iniquity on the Pacific Coast. You can scarcely believe that directly under the large life size painting of the Master knocking at the door of the human hearts (Rev. 3:20) — the door with the latch on the inside — was once a sloppy bar: that upon the walls where now appears Scripture texts, there once hung lewd pictures: that where the rows of seats are, with rocking chairs for the aged and infirm were once gambling tables. That this atmosphere that now knows the voice of Praise and Prayer was once polluted with profanity and ribald song. That where saints and sinners now kneel in prayer once men fought and murder was done. The large dining rooms back of the assembly hall, was once a dance hall. But now every morning after breakfast the Word of God is read to feed the souls of those gathered there, and to lead the unsaved to Christ. Many souls were born into the kingdom because of the messages given by Mother Green at these morning devotion periods. Meetings were also held every night on the street and in the chapel bringing many to repentance.

Another step of faith by Mother Green

was the building of a Church on property she owned at Eagle Point, Oregon, thru prayer; money, material and labor were donated, and the building was completed in less than four weeks.

Seventeen years ago the two Oft boys gave twenty acres of land in memory of their mother, to build a Christian Home. In starting this work Mother Green and her helpers lived in a tent until it blew down, then under the Juniper Trees, until buildings could be put up.

The six boys who built the Church, gave their hearts to God when it was dedicated, some are now preaching the gospel. God blessed with a Bible School for a number of years. Some of the Missionaries are in Africa and one is to sail for China soon. There are around seventeen buildings now and seventy or more, people can be taken care of.

It was a great blessing to Mother Green when her sister, Lelah F. Jones was called into the work about fourteen years ago. For the last eight years she has had charge of the Winston Street Mission. She is now helping at the Mountain Home and the Echo Home.

The Hill Street Mission, managed by Jewel Price, where she received her call to China, was moved to Lincoln Heights on North Broadway, and is still going on for the Lord.

While cooking in Echo Home, Clement Peebler felt led by the Lord to give eighty acres of land in the beautiful Ozarks of Arkansas, to the Christ Faith

Mission. Due to previous lease on this land, six acres of land on highway sixty-two, Gasville, Arkansas was purchased. Where a Log Church and large house for Mothers and Children was erected. Due to inefficient help and the great distance from Los Angeles, we disposed of it to Mrs. Madeford, Mrs. Peebler's daughter, and built a home for Mothers and Children at the Echo Home with the proceeds.

We still have the eighty acres, and any one interested in working for the Lord there, may write to us.

There are many who are now spiritually "lamed," since having been saved, now straying and need our compassion, support and prayers to help them back into the straight and narrow way. Yes we prepare a feast daily for these hungering and needy souls and are sending out a S.O.S. call for intercessors (good samaritans) to come and stand in the gap with us for these weary travelers, beaten and robbed, passing hourly by Christ Faith Mission.

A MIRACLE OF HEALING

In March, 1945, while working in the mission at 101 Winston Street, I fell and injured my back. Thinking it was only wrenched I was prayed for and trusted the Lord to heal it. However, it became more painful so I decided to have it taped and went to Dr. Sandblom who took X-Ray pictures which showed two ribs dislocated and a third partially so. This was about two weeks after the accident, Dr. Sandblom taped me and said I was not to use my arms in any way for three weeks. I had been working right along as we could not get help in the mission and we were feeding many hungry men at that time after both morning and afternoon services. We prayed that the Lord would send in help but had no one at the end of the week. I could very profitably have spent these three weeks in studying the Word and praying but the work was too much for Sister Jones alone. One morning I said, "Lord, if it is your will that I have these three weeks for study and prayer I say Amen, but we must have help here, if not I ask you to heal me for your glory."

On Monday evening we had a wonderful meeting, feeling the presence of the Lord from the beginning. The altar call was given and many sought the Lord. I was praying and felt a burden for the lost, but realized that the saints were gathering to pray for me and I really didn't want them to just then. As they prayed and before they anointed me I fell over on my back and as I lay there praising the Lord my body was lifted off the floor and dropped down three times and I knew that I was healed. The power of God was so strong the saints were all dancing and shouting. After being under the power about an hour and a half I rose and said I was healed. The next morning I took the tape off and called the doctor to tell him I was healed. He said, "When the Lord does it he does a good job." He certainly did and I praise Him for healing me many times of various illnesses. I praise God for such a wonderful Saviour, who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. GOD'S GOLD

In 1906 I moved with my brother and his family from Nebraska to California. On our way we stopped in Florence, Colo., where my two brothers worked in the Gold Mill. We were taken to see the process. Long trains of flat cars loaded with gold ore were coming in from the mountains. The ore was crushed into powder in strong machinery for that purpose, the powder was then placed in large vats and covered and mixed with acid. The last we saw was the furnace where little globules of melted gold rolled out of the fire down little troughs into receptacles, not in great abundance, but every one precious. Some were only the size of a pin head, some a bit larger but all really small. From there we went to the office and were shown a brick of solid gold, weighing fifty pounds, now it was ready for use.

Several years later I was going through lonely days, testing and trying years. One night the Lord brought this whole process before me in a dream, awaking I felt as though I had been in the mill and was seeing it all again. I lay quietly, communing with my Lord—I felt very much melted before Him and prayed that He would let me be pure as gold, though only the size of a pin head. When will we be all melted together into one?
