

GOOD NEWS

This little paper is to strengthen the faith life in all who read it, for truly God has taught us to live by faith for nearly nine years in Christ Faith Mission, Praise His precious Name.

We started with one dollar, four quarters given by dear Sister Dillon, who is now with the Lord. For four weeks, she saved twenty-five cents a week on her food and brought me the dollar. At first I rejected it. Who could start a down town Mission on one dollar? Then with bitter tears, I asked her forgiveness.

Within six days, I had thirty dollars given by friends and I started out to find what rent would be. The second place I went into on Spring Street was dirty and had not been occupied for over a year. There were eight rooms. I went to see the agent and found he wanted \$250 for the lease for eighteen months. I asked him what he would let us have it for, just as it was, dirt and all, and he said \$100, with three weeks' free rent. He was willing to take fifty dollars down and the balance in three weeks. I know God was working.

I had a diamond ring that I pawned for twenty dollars, and in a few hours was in the place cleaning it up. We had a broken-leaved table and a dry-goods box for furniture, with forty cents in money. But God was able to do abundantly above all I could ask or think. Praise His Name. He gave His All for us. What have we given for Him?

Every day is Thanksgiving for us. Just come in to the prayer meeting from eleven to twelve o'clock in the Mission and in the mountain home, or send your requests in, for we know God answers prayer. We rely on Him for our daily bread and rent. We believe that we shall have a Christ Faith Mission without rent some day. Wouldn't that be heavenly? Pray for us.

THE FIRST THANKSGIVING DINNER

We have always had a free Thanksgiving dinner in the Mission. The one I want to tell you about, the most outstanding in the nine years, was the first one. Times were very hard at that time, and many needy people came in the day before Thanksgiving to ask for food. During the day we gave out all the food we had and God seemed to multiply for we helped many.

At six o'clock the cupboard was bare with the exception of two small cans of corn and a dozen or more sweet potatoes. My heart almost failed for there were only three hours before the markets closed, and I had announced a free Thanksgiving dinner for all needy women. But God undertook and a friend, Mrs. Hall, called me by phone from Highland Park and asked about the Thanksgiving dinner. I informed her with trembling voice that it had not arrived.

"With loud exclamations she said, "Why, Mother Green, why did you not let us know?"

I told her that that was the Lord's business and it was all up to Him now. I had done my part.

Well, before nine o'clock, one of our long tables was loaded with good things for a cmplete Thanksgiving dinner fr over one hundred. God never fails. So, dear ones, have faith in God.

FAITH MISSION

Alma Whitaker in the Los Angeles Times:

Everything about the Christ Faith Mission is a little incredible—but it works.

In a modern world obsessed with efficiency it has operated successfully for seven years on the sketchiest bookkeeping and no statistics.

Its very location, at 215 South Spring Street, reeks of incongruous drama. For that is the old Hoffman Cafe, scene of gay parties in pre-war days.

Today the front part of the building is devoted to missionary services, the walls covered with texts from the Scriptures. Balconies, alcoves and private dining rooms are filled with beds for destitute women and babies.

Mrs. Arglee Green, formerly a smart and successful dressmaker and milliner in New York, has dedicated herself to the rescue of the unfortunates of her sex. She founded the mission seven years ago. It has no endowments, no regular income, no contributions from Chest or county.

"But the Lord always provides if we have faith in Him," beams Mrs. Green.

Her faith obviously is justified, for she houses and feeds, comforts and encourages 75 women who otherwise would be shelterless.

Another curious anomaly is that, while organized charity disapproves her

methods, because of her insistence that no registration is necessary, no questions be asked and no records be kept, relief agencies galore pass women along to her care for whom they can make no provision themselves.

"We never turn anyone away. Sometimes we all have to share our beds with sorrowing strangers, but we are glad to do it," says Mrs. Green.

"But it takes money to run a place like this. Where do you get it?" I asked.

Whereupon Mrs. Green recounted tales of answers to prayer through the years. She likewise told proudly how a Sundial story about her work in the Christian Science Monitor brought her donations from all over the country, and even as far afield as China and South America.

Many of her contributions come from former inmates now restored to self-supporting status. While I was interviewing her a young girl entered, kissed her, proclaimed that she now had a job, and donated \$1 from her first week's pay.

There are almost no rules. No woman has to divulge anything about herself that she doesn't wish to. But one rule is sternly held to—all who can must attend the prayer services before breakfast, and they must keep up their beds.

They are, however, free to go job hunting for the rest of the day.

Wednesday is set apart for an all day prayer and fellowship meeting. Everybody invited to come and pray. Friday, all day sewing. Nothing to be sold but to be given to the needy. Come and help and be blessed.

Christmas Tree and party for children, December 22, at one o'clock. All invited.

Thanksgiving Dinner and Christmas Dinner for needy women and girls, 12:30, Nov. 29 and on December 25.

The language of the eye is universal! Eighty-six percent of the knowledge we gain is brought to us through the "eyegate." Easily understood by every tribe and tongue of earth's myriad nations will be this flaming canvas missionary.

Never in all the centuries has God had a spirit filled artist to portray the suffering and agony of the Son of God in its real Jewish setting and in strict accordance with the description of the Word of God.

Praise the Lord for regenerating this great soul and enlist prayer that the Holy Ghost may monopolize him, body, soul and spirit for this unique ministry of art.

Beginning December sixteenth, Dr. Plotkin will unveil the painting each Sunday at three o'clock, P. M. to show

the progress achieved from week to week. TALKING WITH GOD

or

The Secrets of the Prayer Life

Many times the question is asked, "Why does not God answer my prayer?" Now, while no one explanation will meet all cases, I have found two facts generally present:

Ignorance of God's word, and promises, and neglect of continued secret prayer. Because of this vital need, many are now unable to meet the testings of these days. Only those who know God's word, and are walking closely with Him every moment, are able to stand firm, steadfast, and unafraid. Again, one must be fully conscious of God's presence, that He is, and that He hears.

One must also realize that real prayer is prompted by the Holy Spirit, Who knows the will of God, and will not ask amiss. There are certain conditions of mind that grieve the Holy Spirit, and which God will not hear; jealousy, hatred, pride, bitterness in heart, an unforgiving spirit, all hinder true prayer.

Nor should prayer be selfish. Others should be first. Some give healing the first place, failing to know that grace sufficient is far more precious than bodily healing. One may be in danger of

spiritual pride, and need humbling and like Paul, need the 'thorn' lest they be 'puffed up.'

One must be reconciled to circumstances that God has permitted to surround them. Only when willing that God should have His way, can He use us. God uses deaf, dumb, blind, shut in people, broken, empty lives, that are willing to do His will.

Praise, instead of murmuring, brings untold blessing; no one need be useless. All God asks is a willing obedient heart, and He does the rest, opens doors and gives power in prayer and service. A genuine life of faith and work is not easy. It means work, strength, energy used, it means sacrifice, standing between the power of darkness and those we would help, it means love. 'Without love we are nothing.

God always answers true prayer. If we make a mistake in what we ask, He says 'No.' That is an answer. If in doubt as to His will, leave it for Him to decide. If sure it is His will, just take it by faith. In such case, He gives the 'gift of faith,'
