Funded 11 Plus Tuition - what is included?

- Information meeting for parents at Boldmere Junior School on Tuesday 18th June at 16:45
- Baseline assessment at Boldmere Junior School on Tuesday 2nd July 2024 15:30 – 17:00
- One academic year of fully funded 11+ tuition by Tintagel tutoring on Tuesdays starting on 17th September 2024.
- Lessons will take place at Boldmere Junior School or Tintagel Tutoring, Upper Holland Road, Sutton Coldfield.

Is my child eligible for free tuition?

All children must be in year 5, planning to take the 11+ entrance exam and of high ability due to the competitive nature of the 11+ exam. In addition to this they need to meet **one** of the following criteria.

MINORITY ETHNIC GROUP

What if my child doesn't meet the criteria?

You are welcome to come along for the baseline assessment.

Depending on the results of this assessment and the number of children involved – there may be some spaces left available which will allow some flexibility with the criteria.

Helping your child reach their full potential

If your child does not gain a place in the funded tuition classes, there will be an opportunity for you to book either 11 Plus tuition or general English and maths tuition privately with Tintagel Tutoring.

FAQs

Why do they need to do a baseline assessment?

The 11 plus tuition course will be very challenging and is not appropriate for all children. 11+ tuition is not the right course for every child and it requires a lot of work from both children and parents – we wouldn't want children to be doing this if it's not the right path for them.

How will children be selected for the funded tuition?

This will be based on those achieving the necessary score in the baseline assessment and then meeting the appropriate criteria which is information Boldmere Junior School will share with us.

What happens if there are too many children and insufficient spaces?

The children who scored most highly in the baseline assessment and who meet the criteria stated will be allocated places.

How long are the lessons?

One hour.

FAQs

Will lessons only be during term time?

No, they will continue during the holidays. During holiday periods, all lessons will be held at Tintagel Tutoring. There will be one week during Easter with no lessons and two weeks during the summer holidays.

What if we are away during the holidays?

You will simply let us know and we will email the work for your child to complete independently.

What if my child is not well?

Please let us know and then we will email the work – hopefully when your child feels better they will be able to complete it at home so that they do not fall behind.

Will there be any homework?

Yes, homework is set every week and it is expected that children will complete all the homework set before the next lesson. This work will be challenging and they are highly likely to need support at home to complete it effectively.

 What if my child changes their mind and doesn't want to attend or we change our mind?

If this happens, please talk to the tutor so we can see if there is anything that can be done to make this work better for you. If not, then you would simply stop attending but this would mean that your child loses their place and will not be able to rejoin again later.

What if we miss a lesson?

If you can't attend for any reason, we ask that you let us know. To accidentally miss one lesson is not a problem – these things happen. However, if you were to regularly miss lessons your child would be removed from the course.

FAQs

How many children will be in a lesson?

A maximum of 10 children will be in each class

Who will teach the lessons?

Christina Engers, who is a fully qualified teacher and experienced 11+ tutor.

 What happens if my child doesn't gain a funded tuition place but I still want tutoring for them?

Speak to Tintagel Tutoring and they will let you know what tuition is available for your child and how much this would cost.

 What if my child doesn't get a high enough score on the baseline assessment for 11+ tuition?

They will not be eligible for the funded 11+ tuition, but Tintagel Tutoring will have other private tuition options that could suit your child to help them accelerate their progress at school in maths and English.

How were the criteria for the funded tuition set?

This was agreed upon in conjunction with the business that provides the funding. They would like to fund tuition for children who belong to groups which are underrepresented in the financial industry.
