Cattle can unload before 4:00 pm or after the conclusion of the pig show on Friday night. **NO CATTLE CAN BE UNLOADED DURING THE PIG SHOW.** On Saturday, Cattle trailers can enter the gates and be unloaded before 7:00 am OR after the conclusion of the breeding goat show. Once the sheep shows start, Cattle can be walked in and use the back entrance through the wash racks to get the ties. Tack can be unloaded after the conclusion of the goat show. This will keep from interrupting the other shows. Dairy/Beef Cattle do not have to arrive until Sunday, June 27th.

Entry Fees

- \$25 per animal for Classes Early Bird Discount (entered online by June 18 at midnight)
- \$50 per animal for classes (After June 18 or Day of Show)
- \$10 per exhibitor for showmanship Early Bird Discount (entered online by June 18 at midnight)
- \$20 per exhibitor for showmanship (After June 18 or Day of Show)
- \$1 per peewee showmanship

Breed sponsorship is available. \$250.00 per breed

- ❖ Health Papers are required and will be checked upon check in
- ❖ Buckles for Overall Dairy, Brahman Influence and Non-Brahman Influence
- ❖ No Power outlets outside of barn, Generators are required for power
- ❖ NO Generators allowed under the barn or next to the barn
- ❖ No trim chutes in ties or walkways
- ❖ There are a few shaded areas, provide own shade
- ❖ We will have a miniature division
- ❖ We will have a Pee-Wee class for showmanship
- ❖ Judges and Show Management decisions are final
- ❖ Follow LSU Rules unless otherwise stated
- ❖ No refunds after June 18, unless show is cancelled
- ❖ Exhibitors must show the animals entered in the show, exceptions for peewee showmanship
- ❖ Open to exhibitors ages 0-19 Code of Conduct and Covid Release forms must be completed upon arrival

Beef

Classes will be as follows:

May 1, 2021 and after
March 1 to April 30, 2021
January 1 to February 28, 2021
November 1 to December 31, 2020
September 1 to October 31, 2020
July 1 to August 31, 2020
May 1 to June 30, 2020
March 1 to April 30, 2020
January 1 to February 28, 2020
November 1 to December 31, 2019
September 1 to October 31, 2019
July 1 to August 31, 2019
May 1 to June 30, 2019
March 1 to April 30, 2019
January 1 to February 28, 2019
*Sept. 1 to December 31, 2018(Heifers Only)
*Calved prior to Sept. 1, 2017(Miniature Cattle Only)

Commercial Heifers and Steers will show by weight. Weight Classes will depend on the number of entries.

Breeding classes will be Brahman and Non Brahman unless 5 or more of a breed or the breed is sponsored.

Miniature Cattle will be separated by Brahman or Non Brahman unless there are 5 or more of a breed or the breed is sponsored.

- ❖ Steers can be shown with or without hair
- ❖ Steers & Commercial Heifers: NO SHEENS OR HAIR ADDITIVES ALLOWED.
Soap and Water **ONLY**
- ❖ Commercial Heifers may be split Brahman and Non-Brahman, depending on numbers
- ❖ Registered Heifers are NOT eligible to show in Commercial classes
- ❖ Registration papers must be presented day of show, Papers pending will be accepted
- ❖ All bulls over 6 months of age **MUST** have nose ring
- ❖ Sept. 1 to December 31 heifer class must have calf at side or have certification of pregnancy from a licensed veterinarian.
- ❖ For Showmanship, no switching animals for the championship drive. Must use the same animal in the class and the championship drive
- ❖ Follow LSU Rules unless otherwise stated
- ❖ Miniature cattle will have a cow class as per LSU Rules.

Dairy

Classes will be AOB unless 5 or more of a breed or the breed is sponsored.

All registered dairy animals older than 6 months of age must be dehorned or be naturally polled. Horn scurs are allowed.

Any dairy animals in a class younger than the senior 2-year old cow class that have calved will automatically be moved to the senior 2-year old cow class.

Commercial Dairy Heifers that have not calved will be weighed. Classes will be determined by the range of weights of heifers.

Commercial Dairy Cows will show together.

Follow LSU Rules unless otherwise stated
