All outfits must be age appropriate

Ages 0–10 wear Watermelon Inspired attire

No exposed midriffs

Ages 0–5: No fake teeth or fake eyelashes

Hair and makeup should be age appropriate

General Rules & Information

Admission is \$5 per person ages 5 and up (4 and under free)

Everyone pays admission except the contestant.

Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated

Anyone displaying poor conduct will be asked to leave without refund

Judges are qualified and not from this area

All judges' decisions are final

No refunds will be issued

Only one person allowed backstage with contestant

Failure to follow backstage rules may result in disqualification
