## <u>To be eligible to compete in the MISS division of Beauregard Watermelon Festival Pageant contestant must be:</u>

- 1. Born Female
- 2. Must live within 50 miles of Sugartown, LA.
- 3. Must have never been pregnant, not pregnant at the time of this pageant, nor have terminated a pregnancy.
- 4. Must have never been married.
- 5. Must be 18 years of age by December 31, 2025
- 6. Must have never been arrested or convicted of a felony or misdemeanor, or be it any other type of legal infraction.
- 7. Must not hold any other title that would require Queen to attend LAFF.
- 8. Miss Queen winners are requested to compete at the LAFF convention in February 2026 in Baton Rouge, LA.
