

Bowl Cozy Pattern – 9inch

Hoop Polymesh stabilizer.

2 – 10in squares of fabric

1 – 10in square of batting

Stitch **Color 1: Placement Line** .

Place batting on top of Polymesh inside the placement lines.

Stitch **Color 2: Tack Down** .

Trim the batting close against the stitching lines.

Place the main (inner) fabric on top of the batting and smooth down.

Stitch **Color: 3 Pattern Outline** to secure the top fabric.

Stitch **Color 4: Quilting** design.

Remove the embroidery from the hoop.

Cut out the pattern along the outer stitching line.

Trim away the excess Polymesh stabilizer from the seamline.

Use this pattern to cut the lining fabric.

Stitch up the “V” indentations in the lining and quilted pieces to create the dimensional bowl shapes. Press the darts open.

Fit the bowl shapes into each other - with right sides together.

Stitch around the outside bowl top edge with a ¼" seam - leave an opening to turn project right-side out.

Turn bowl right-side out and stitch or fuse the opening closed.

Stitch bowl through all layers around the top edge at about a ¼"

Then from corner to corner, creating an “X” through the bowl.
