Rome to Miami—Ports of Call

CIVITAVECCHIA (ROME), ITALY

From the port of Civitavecchia it is not far to the imposing ancient city of Rome, incomparable in terms of monuments, gardens, villas, and works of art: to name but a few, the Coliseum, the Capitol, Saint Peter's Basilica, ancient Ostia with the famous mosaics in the Baths of Neptune.

VALENCIA, SPAIN

Valencia has many interesting attractions and monuments tourists love visiting. The largest square of the town, called the Placa de l'Ajuntament, consists of a movie theater, a town hall, and with many restaurants and bars. Every afternoon, an event called the Las Fallas takes place in this square. Part of the celebration includes fireworks of the mascletà.

LISBON, PORTUGAL

Portugal's capital is an 18th-century city - elegant, open to the sea and carefully planned. Most places of interest are within easy walking distance. Rossio Square, the heart of Lisbon since medieval times, is an ideal place to start exploring. Many rebuilt houses with original façades provide stores and restaurants with modern interiors. High above Baixa is Bairro Alto - with its teeming nightlife.

PONTA DELGADA, AZORES

Your ship will pull into port right by the city and you're a short walk away from the whitewashed buildings, arches, and waterfront promenade that make this city so visually appealing to visitors. Beyond the city center of Ponta Delgada is much to explore. A Ponta Delgada cruise port of call is the gateway to the lush nature of São Miguel, which is the largest island in the Portuguese Azores archipelago. São Miguel has cloud forests, volcanoes, crater lakes, botanical gardens, and pretty beaches next to dramatic cliffs.

BRIDGETOWN, BARBADOS

Barbados scores highly on just about every front. It offers first-rate sightseeing: dotted around the rolling and lush interior are plantation homes and glorious botanical gardens to visit, and the British colonial garrison and parts of the capital Bridgetown are a Unesco World Heritage Site.

FORT DE FRANCE, MARTINIQUE

Breathtaking natural beauty; hotels, villas, and Creole residences to suit every style of travel; pulsating authenticity, traditions and culture; magnificent protected hiking trails, intriguing mangrove tours, and canyoning adventures; world-famous surfing, stand-up paddle boarding, bill fishing, and every other conceivable water sport or just relaxing on the beach.

PHILLIPSBURG, ST. MAARTEN

For starters, there's Wathey Square, a shopping and dining hub that is an easy way to pass time upon arrival in port, and Front Street offers a wealth of shops and boutiques. Beach goers can head to Little Bay Beach for a day of playing on the shoreline or the Sunset Bar and Grill where they can watch sun dwellers get blasted by the gust from jet engines as the planes take off at the neighboring airport.

SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO

San Juan, Puerto Rico's capital and largest city, sits on the island's Atlantic coast. Its widest beach fronts the Isla Verde resort strip, known for its bars, nightclubs and casinos. Cobblestoned Old San Juan features colorful Spanish colonial buildings and 16th-century landmarks including El Morro and La Fortaleza, massive fortresses with sweeping ocean views, as well as the Paseo de la Princesa bayside promenade.

Full payment is due no later than July 15, 2019, or booking will automatically cancel for non-payment and no refund made. A passport valid for at least 6 months past date of travel is necessary for each traveler. **CANCELLATION POLICY:** 50% penalty 60-45 days prior to departure; 75% penalty 45-31 days prior; 100% penalty 30-0 days prior to departure. Cancellations due to covered reasons (medical, death, etc.) will require you to make a claim through the travel insurance company for reimbursement of penalties.
