

## **I. Policy Statement**

This plan represents but one of many steps in our ongoing efforts to provide a safe environment for our players, fans, and families to enjoy the games and our facilities. Our commitment to safety can only be successful if each and every person involved in our organization reads, understands, and abides by this plan. The plan itself will be continuously reviewed, revised, and updated to ensure that it is up to date with the latest suggestions and ideas of the medical field, emergency personnel, and input from our organizational family. This plan is meant to provide a framework within which we will conduct all baseball & softball activities.

## **II. Medical Emergency**

- If a Board Member is on premise, they will assume responsibility for the scene.
- If no Board Member is on premise, a Kimmell volunteer (Coach) will take control of the scene.
- Direct someone to call 911.
- Ask for anyone on the property who has medical training to assist.
- Keep other players and parents clear of the scene (parents of any child injured would be the exception to this).
- Direct someone to clear a path for emergency vehicles to get to the scene.
- Notify the Board President of the situation immediately.
- If parents are not at the property, they should be notified immediately.
- If the emergency involves a player, get their Medical Information Form from the Concession stand to give to emergency personnel when they arrive.
- Complete the Incident/Injury Report and place it in the proper location in the Concession Stand.

## **III. Medical Injury – nonemergency**

- If a Board Member is on premise, they will assume responsibility to ensure proper care is given.
- If no Board Member is on premise, a Kimmell volunteer (Coach) will be responsible to make sure proper care is given.
- Ask for anyone on the property who has medical training to assist if needed.
- Keep other players and parents clear of the scene (parents of any child injured would be the exception to this).
- Notify the Board President of the situation as soon as reasonably possible.
- If parents are not at the property, they should be notified as appropriate.
- Complete the Incident/Injury Report and place it in the proper location in the Concession Stand.
