

SAFETY POLICY

It is important that all attendees follow rules and SAFETY protocols while attending the dance so that everyone can have a fun and safe time! Please review and sign-off that you are aware of the following safety rules:

- All attendees must stay on the gym level only.
- For no reason should attendees or chaperones access the stairs or elevator.
- While attending the dance, attendees are not permitted to be outside congregating in the parking lot, or around the buildings on property.
- No attendees are permitted to bring guests that are not pre-registered.
- No alcohol or drugs are permitted on the premise.
- No profanity
- All dancing must be appropriate in nature
- Music will be clean and appropriate in order to provide an environment where all feel comfortable.
- Smoking must be done outside in front of the gym only. Cigarette butts must be cleaned up and not left on the pavement.
- All attendees must be aware of the fire exit doors in case of an emergency.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION POLICY

The DISCIPLINARY ACTION POLICY is to ensure that, when necessary, representatives from the dance committee can correct any behavior problems that may arise during the dance. There are reasonable rules and guidelines for attendees to follow. These have not been put in place to restrict the freedoms of our attendees, but rather they are in consideration of their safety, and the overall protection of the dance event, attendees, volunteers, property, and our overall event practices.

If an attendee or chaperone exhibits problematic behavior, attendees will be given opportunities to correct the behavior, unless it is one of severity. The following are the steps that will be followed.

1. Coaching (informal) – It will be discussed along with the individual and the individual’s chaperone and/or residential home supervisor (via phone or in person) at the time of the behavior with hopes the behavior will end.
2. Verbal Warning (formal) - If during the same event, or a future event, the individual displays problematic behavior, whether it be the same behavior, or new, the individual along with the individual’s chaperone and/or residential home supervisor (via phone or in person) will meet outside of the dancing area to discuss the behaviors.
3. Final Warning (formal) – If an individual continues to display problematic behavior that could bring harm to attendees, volunteers, property, and our overall event practices the committee can decide to suspend the individual for an agreed amount of time. This will be discussed with the individual’s chaperone and/or residential home supervisor (via phone or in person)
