The Nature Box will always take children's rights into account on all aspects of our sessions.

We believe that children have the right to:

- Use their voice
- Be in a safe environment
- Have a quality education experience
- Have privacy and dignity during toileting situations
- Have access to healthy food and drink
- Have their own religious beliefs, views and opinions
- Have their own cultural values, beliefs and opinions
- Wear clothing that is comfortable and meets their religious requirements
- Space to make friends and practice social situations
- Democratic learning

We use the United Nations Convention of the Rights of the Child (UNCRC 1989) as a guideline to children's rights and how to accommodate these.
