The Instituto Guimarães Rosa (IGR) was inaugurated on March 15, 1970. The IGRs are institutions directly subordinated to the Head of the Diplomatic Mission or consular office of Brazil in each country, constituting the main instrument for the execution of our cultural policy abroad. Its activities are related to the systematic teaching of the Portuguese language spoken in Brazil; the diffusion of Brazilian Literature; the distribution of informative material about Brazil; the organization of visual arts exhibitions and theatrical shows; the co-editing and distribution of texts by national authors; to the diffusion of our erudite and popular music; the dissemination of Brazilian cinematography; in addition to other forms of Brazilian Cultural expression, such as lectures, seminars and others.

Basic Portuguese Course

The Basic Portuguese Course presents the language of Brazil through culture, work and travel-related topics and everyday situations. Learners engage in the new language through grammar, vocabulary, listening and speaking activities to enhance conversational skills. Music, movies, cultural activities and events are included in every term.

Certificate: A certificate from the Embassy of Brazil is awarded at the end of each level.

Duration: Basic 1-A to Advance 2 (3 months each).

Registration: first two weeks in the new term (January, April or September) 10 am – 4 pm. Sign up virtually using the links that will be posted on our Facebook/Instagram page during the registration periods.



Days: Mondays & Wednesdays or Tuesdays & Thursdays.

Class Times: 5:00 – 7:00 pm.

Term fee: GYD \$10,000

Celpe-Bras Preparatory Course

The Celpe-Bras is the Brazilian Portuguese proficiency exam that certifies candidates worldwide. The Brazil-Guyana Cultural Centre administers the exam in Guyana and offers this preparatory course to acquaint students with the level of language and tasks required by the exam.

Certificate: Students who pass the exam are awarded the certificate by the Brazilian Government. The Celpe-Bras certificate is recognized by Brazilian scholarship programs as proof of proficiency in Portuguese.

Duration: 3 terms (3 months each).

Days: Fridays

Class Times: 3:00 – 5:00 pm.

Term fee: GYD \$8,000

Requirements: to have completed the Basic Portuguese Course or placement exam/interview.
