"We are filling a huge need in the community by ensuring that these people are not returned to the streets where their recovery would be jeopardized," Hollenbeck emphasizes.

Furthermore, Martha's Village & Kitchen is equipped with an on-site clinic managed by DAP Health, which significantly enhances the accessibility of medical care to the residents and the local community. This clinic not only provides basic healthcare but also preventive services, ensuring better health outcomes for underserved populations.

### **Maria's Journey to Recovery and Stability**

Among those who have found refuge and a path to a new life at Martha's Village is Maria, a single mother who faced homelessness with her teenage daughter after losing her home. "I came to Martha's on September 30th, at a time when I felt all doors were closing on me," Maria recounts. Her journey through addiction recovery and subsequent struggles, including a stroke and the loss of her housing, illustrates the profound impact of Martha's integrated services.

With the help of Martha's Village, Maria was able to stabilize her health through their medical recuperation program.
