

Categories for Quilt Show 2026

1. Small Quilts - maximum perimeter of 250". Entry may be Traditional, Contemporary or Modern that uses a published pattern or a combination of original elements along with blocks or elements of published patterns. These can be from patterns, books, magazines or social media.
2. Medium Quilts - perimeter between 251" and 300". Entry may be Traditional, Contemporary or Modern that uses a published pattern or a combination of original elements along with blocks or elements of published patterns. These can be from patterns, books, magazines or social media.
3. Large Quilts - perimeter over 301". Entry may be Traditional, Contemporary or Modern that uses a published pattern or a combination of original elements along with blocks or elements of published patterns. These can be from patterns, books, magazines or social media.
4. Modern - Must be an **original** design by entrant. All sizes and any quilting methods are accepted. At the heart of modern quilting is innovation. The emphasis is on design and originality not the perfection of the technique.
5. Art - This category may include any of the following and any size is acceptable.
 - Abstract and Improvisational - entry must be non-pictorial, with emphasis on colour, line and design.
 - OR
 - Human or Animal Form - Entry must illustrate some recognizable aspect of the human or animal form.
 - OR
 - Landscapes and Still Life - Entry must illustrate some recognizable aspect of natural or man made scenery or a recognizable object.
6. Appliqué - Any size is acceptable. Appliqué is a needlework technique in which fabric is attached to a larger background fabric to create pictures or patterns. The fabric can be attached by hand, machine or fused with stitching.
7. Challenge - TBD
