Development Site - 20 Firle Road, North Lancing, West Sussex, BN15 ONZ

Set within the built-up area boundary of Adur is this 3 acre development site. Currently occupied by a single detached home the gardens extend beyond the home to the edge of the South Downs National Park and enjoys far reaching views across Lancing to the English Channel. Subject to Planning offers will be considered based on feedback from a previously refused planning application for 9 homes with a more local vernacular and increased BNG.



The Property

Currently occupied by a modernised detached family home the gardens extend to some 3 acres, including the access, and is surrounded by well established mature hedgerows.

Proposal

Offers are being sought on a 'subject to planning' basis for the comprehensive redevelopment of the site. Previous planning applications have established the suitability of the site for development (access and within the built-up area boundary) but failed to address the prevailing design and character of the area. Further BNG requirements will also need to be addressed.

Any offer will need to show that the previous planning applications have been factored into the proposal and all of the issues addressed. These include;

• Respecting the prevailing pattern, roof pitch and design of local properties, to not Contact Matthew at The Land & New Homes Organisation for access and further disturb the character of the area.



- Creating and emphasising bio-diversity corridors between the properties and a buffer surrounding the site—including its structured management going forward.
- Respect the natural topography of the site—minimising spoil/chalk removal.
- Limit light pollution and impact on neighbouring wildlife.
- Consider green roofs, a cross-over road arrangement, installation of fire appliance turning head within the site and onsite use of chalk for plastering/ rendering.

Location

Located on the northern fringe of Lancing, a popular coastal town located between the thriving town of Worthing and City of Brighton & Hove. North Lancing is set in an elevated position on the edge of the South Downs National Park and provides panoramic views, from many homes, out across the coast to the English Channel.
