## QUILT DIVISIONS AND CATEGORIES

Placement in the Master or the Artisan divisions is determined by the qualifications of the "Maker" of the quilt top. Please review the flow chart provided with the Entry Form and Rules Sheet to determine if you enter your quilts in the Master or Artisan divisions. Judged quilts will receive a written critique upon pickup from the judge. Ribbon placement is at the discretion of the judges. Ribbons are awarded to the quilt and on occasion, not all ribbons are awarded.

## MASTER DIVISION

100 Art Quilt - Any size quilt with an original design using any technique or combination of techniques or materials in a non- traditional way by one or two people.
200 Pieced Medium - Any quilt that is predominantly pieced, from 24-72 inches on any side by one or two people.
250 Pieced Large - Any quilt that is predominantly pieced, that is greater than 72 inches on any side by one or two people.
300 Applique' Medium - Any quilt that is predominantly appliqued by hand or machine from 24-60 inches on any side by one or two people.
350 Applique' Large - Any quilt that is predominantly appliqued by hand or machine, greater than 60 inches on any one side by one or two people.
400 Mixed Technique - Any size quilt with basically equal amounts of several techniques; pieced, applique', hand or machine embroidery, beaded, painted, etc. by one or two people.
500 Whole Cloth - Any size quilt that is not pieced or appliqued with dominant work that is quilting.
600 Miniature - 24 inch maximum on each side.

## ARTISAN DIVISION

700 Art Quilt - Any size quilt with an original design using any technique or combination of techniques or materials in a non-traditional way by one or two people.
800 Pieced One Person Medium - Any quilt predominantly pieced from 24-72 inches on any side, pieced and quilted by one person.
850 Pieced Two Person Medium - Any quilt predominantly pieced from 24-72 inches on any side, pieced and quilted by two people.

900 Pieced One Person Large - Any quilt predominantly pieced that is greater than 72 inches on any side, pieced and quilted by one person.
950 Pieced Two Person Large - Any quilt predominantly pieced that is greater than 72 inches on any one side, pieced and quilted by two people.
1000 Applique' One Person Medium - Any quilt that is predominantly appliqued by hand or machine, from 24-72 inches on any one side. Appliqued and quilted by one person.
1050 Applique' Two Person Medium - Any quilt that is predominantly appliqued by hand or machine, from 24-72 inches on any one side. Appliqued and quilted by two people.
1100 Applique' One Person Large - Any quilt that is predominantly appliqued by hand or machine, greater than 72 inches on any side, appliqued and quilted by one person.
1150 Applique' Two Person Large- Any quilt that is predominantly appliqued by hand or machine, greater than 72 inches on any side, appliqued and quilted by two people.
1200 Miniature - 24 inches maximum on each side.
1300 Mixed technique - Any size quilt with basically equal amounts of several techniques; pieced, applique', hand or machine embroidery, beaded, painted, etc. by one or two people.
1400 First Time Entry - Must be the first quilted project entered into ANY judged quilt show. Construction of the quilt top must be done entirely by the entrant. May use any technique. 24 inches or larger on any side. One or two person.
1500 Hand Quilted Medium - Any quilt that is 24-62 inches on any side entirely quilted by hand.
1550 Hand Quilted Large - Any Quilt greater than 62 inches on any side entirely quilted by hand.
1600 Group - Any quilt made by three or more people (i.e. block exchanges, swaps, round robins, etc.) machine or hand quilted.
1700 Kit / Block of the Month - (Not eligible for Best of Show) Any size quilt made from fabrics in a kit or Block of the Month, even if some fabrics are substitutes or the fabrics selected and/or cut by someone other than the maker, one or two person.
1800 Modern - Any quilt that is inspired by modern design, minimalism, asymmetry, expansive negative space, improvisational piecing, high contrast, and/or many solid fabrics by one or two people.
1900 Group Challenges - This category encompasses those quilts created by groups of friends using the same pattern.
1930 Thirty Something Guild Challenge - The theme for this challenge is Thirty Something. Use your imagination! Quilts must be no more than 30 inches on their longest side. Entry is free for this challenge.
2000 Wearables / Bags - Non- Judged - Quilted vests, jackets, skirts, dresses and bags. These items will not be judged and will not be available for sale.
2100 Youth (Non-Judged) - Any size quilt created by a person 18 years of age or younger at the time entry forms are submitted for the WAQG 2024 Show. Encourage your children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews to enter a quilt. The youth must be sponsored by a WAQG member.
