Pretty much none, we all expect respectable conversation and questions during lecture.

When there is a pause or question in lecture the expectation is for the class to participate.

Quizzes, essays and reflection exercises

We had a quiz and reflection at the end of every topic, writing assignments and exams

there is at least 1 reading per week, but with class discussion it's not the end of the world if you don't read the article. exams are extensive, but honestly enjoyable due to the content.

The workload in this class makes sense, with reflections, writing assignments, quizzes and written exams being the bulk of the grading. Sometimes it felt like busy work with the large variety of modes, but it was all doable.

Only two exams and writing assignemnts. With a quiz and reflection for each topic.

Some of the readings got to be a lot each week but they were reasonable because we went over them in lecture.

Only take home quizes and exams.

we had homework that was some quizzes and our exams and writing assignments it was all doable and we knew far in advance

we do a lot of quizzes which are easy

The readings are crucial for each week's material and quizzes. Without the reading you will understand the lectures, but you will have a much better grasp on the details with the readings. The readings also help greatly on the in class assignments and the weekly quizzes. Much of the questions require the knowledge from the readings.

The workload was manageable throughout the course. There were times where I had loads of work but it's not something I'm going to complain.

In class assignments at the end of every unit and a small quiz over the weekend. Provides 2 weeks for larger assignments which are engaging and very doable.

The workload was pretty light for this course. We had four large assignments that took a lot of our homework time. Also the required readings could get long but were manageable.

the only assignments are big ones, which can be overwhelming because it is worth so many points, being a large chunk of the overall grade

Some homework like quizzes and readings was good. As well as doable tests and writing assignments

Lots of essay and short response work.

The class is so interesting and relevant, but it is challenging for me to remember how to discuss them when put into the reflection form, comparing quickly to videos, etc. It takes me a while to formulate my thoughts and get the concepts fluidly synthesized within a writing prompt.

Workload on itself is pretty manageable. With other classes involved it is a little difficult, but it is still manageable.

I want to say that the grading could be done faster, but I wasn't frustrated as it was very visible how much Deb had going on her own academic life on top of teaching and she was working hard to get it all done.

As mentioned before, not frustrated that grading took longer than hoped, but wish the grades for previous writing assignments or exams were released 2-3 days before the next assignment so I could utilize the feedback.

Sometimes the feedback would be given a little bit late that it would not be super helpful when working on new assignments

sometimes feedback took a little long to get back from assignments, so if there is a way to get feedback a little earlier it'd be perfect

Feedback was on time, useful, and very detailed.

Assignments are graded extremely slow, sometimes after our next big assignment is due so we don't get feedback before exams, etc.

Faster feedback

We were expected to not only be present but understand the material before moving on. This sets high expectations to do work we are all capable of.

The instructors expectations are very reasonable given the course matter. For many of the students it is their first economics class and we are not expected to go in with a full knowledge of even basic economic theories. The professor did a wonderful job teaching us the basics without overwhelming us.
