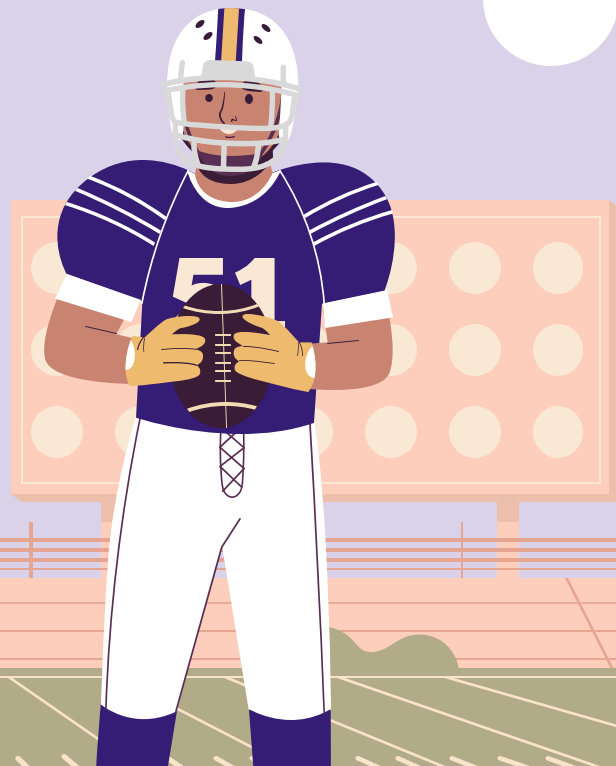

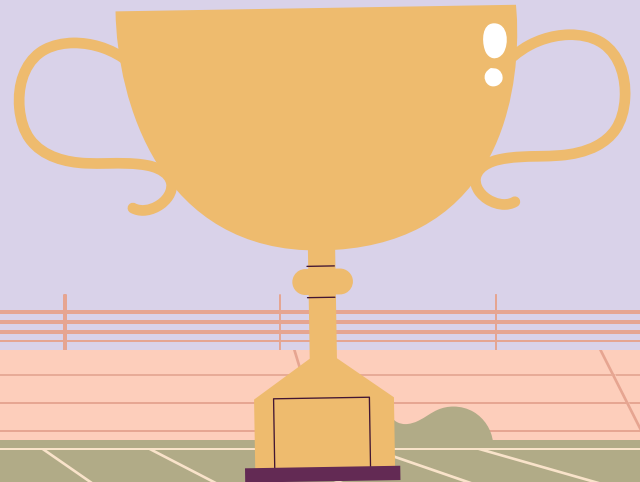

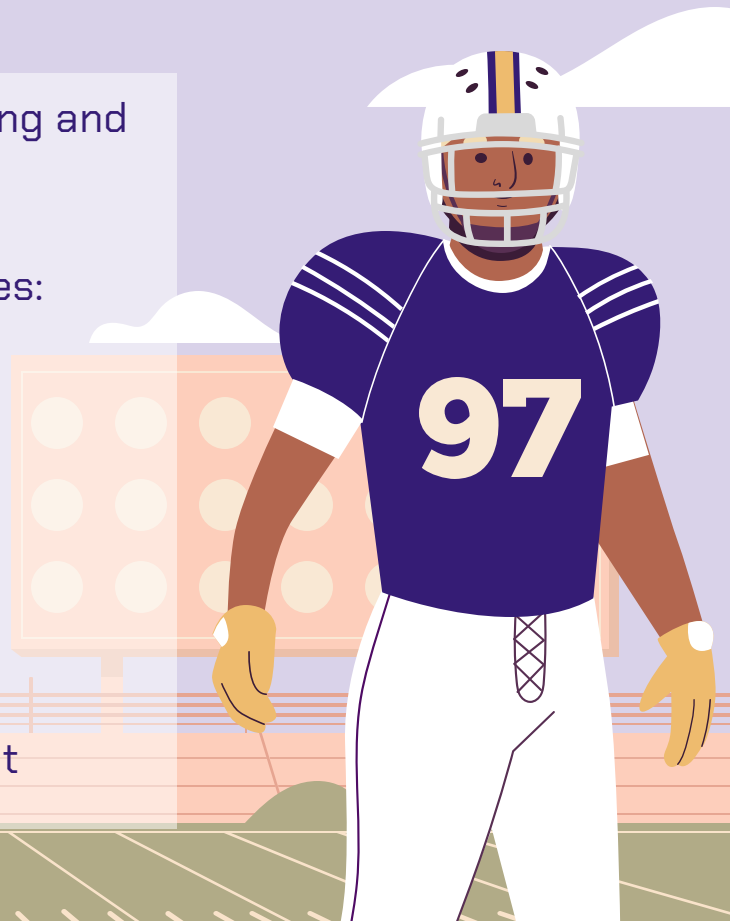


Senior Football Mom/Dad

The role of a Senior Football Mom/Dad involves coordinating and supporting various team traditions, events, and parent involvement throughout the season.

By working together, we can keep families informed and ensure the website is a helpful resource all season long.

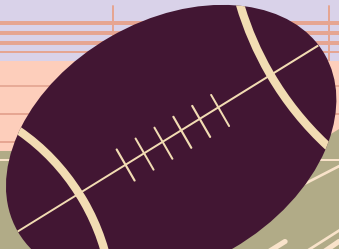
Varsity Dinner Volunteers

Team dinners are held the evening before each game to ensure our players are well-nourished and to build team camaraderie.

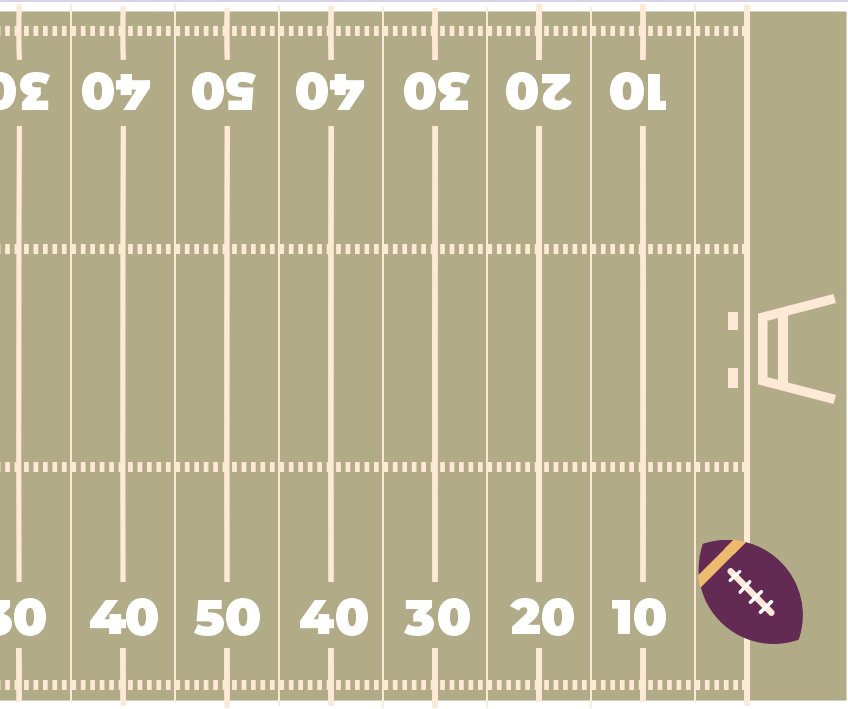
We need parent volunteers each week to:

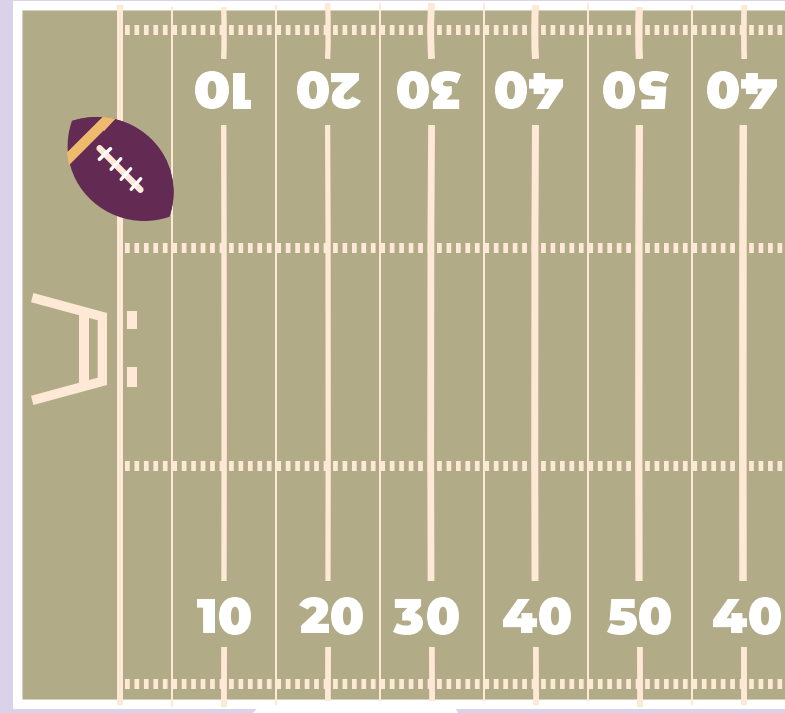

Varsity Breakfast Club Volunteers

- Be present every Saturday morning to set up breakfast, serve the athletes, and clean up afterward

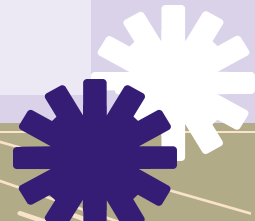
Spirit Committee

The Spirit Committee helps bring energy, encouragement, and school pride to life throughout the season! Volunteers help coordinate and create:

- Pep Rally items and support (typically 4 per season: Senior Night, Homecoming, Lights Out, and one additional)
- Locker room decorations to boost team morale
- Spirit banners for players and events
- Appreciation gifts for the band, cheerleaders, Sky Dancers, managers, and trainers

Homecoming Committee

Help us make Homecoming a fun, spirited, and memorable week for our athletes! This committee supports all things parade and celebration-related, including:

- Decorating a school hallway
- Collecting candy for athletes to throw during the parade
- Renting trailers for float transportation
- Coordinating simple props or “costumes” [e.g., mustaches, eye patches, sunglasses]
- Decorating trailers with lightweight elements [durable for rowdy riders!]
- Providing coolers with ice and water for athletes and coaches [also used as float seating]
- Supplying trash bags for cleanup after the parade

Banquet Committee

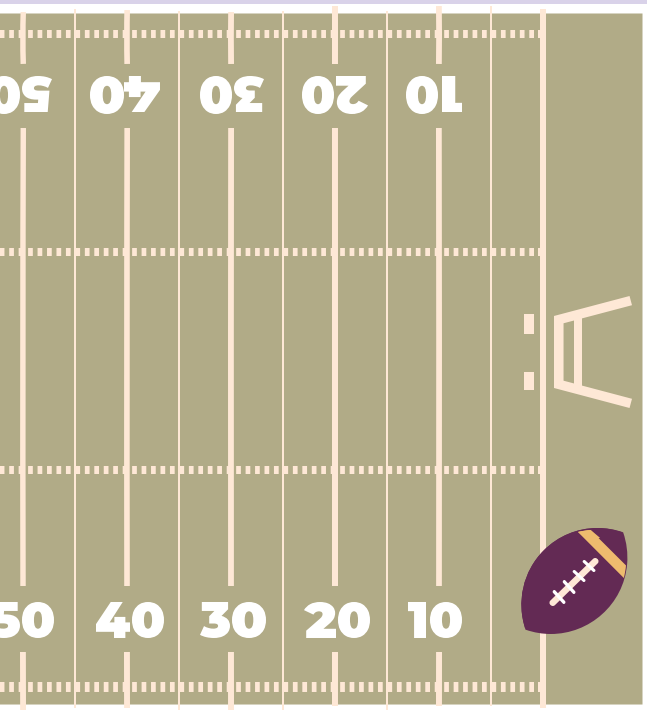
The Banquet Committee helps plan and execute a memorable end-of-season celebration for our athletes and families. Volunteer responsibilities may include:

- Coordinating food and banquet logistics
- Decorating the venue and setting up tables
- Creating and arranging photo backdrops
- Assisting with clean-up after the event

7-on-7 Volunteers



Athletes will have the opportunity to compete in 7-on-7 tournaments throughout the summer. Parent volunteers play a key role in supporting the team by **transporting coolers with ice and water** to local tournaments.

Select athletes will participate in State Qualifying Tournaments (SQT). We need volunteers to:

- Attend Friday games (typically 3 or more games)
- Transport tents and supplies
- Creating and managing a parent sign-up for snacks and drinks

If/when the team qualifies for the State Tournament in College Station (June 27–29):

- Secure a block of hotel rooms for athletes
- Serve as hotel chaperones
- Coordinate transport of tents, coolers, and team essentials

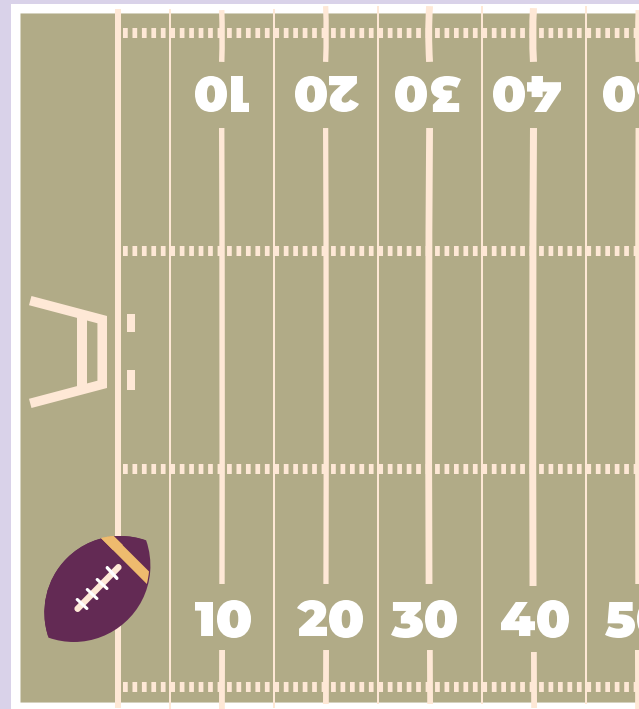
Falcon Head Volunteers

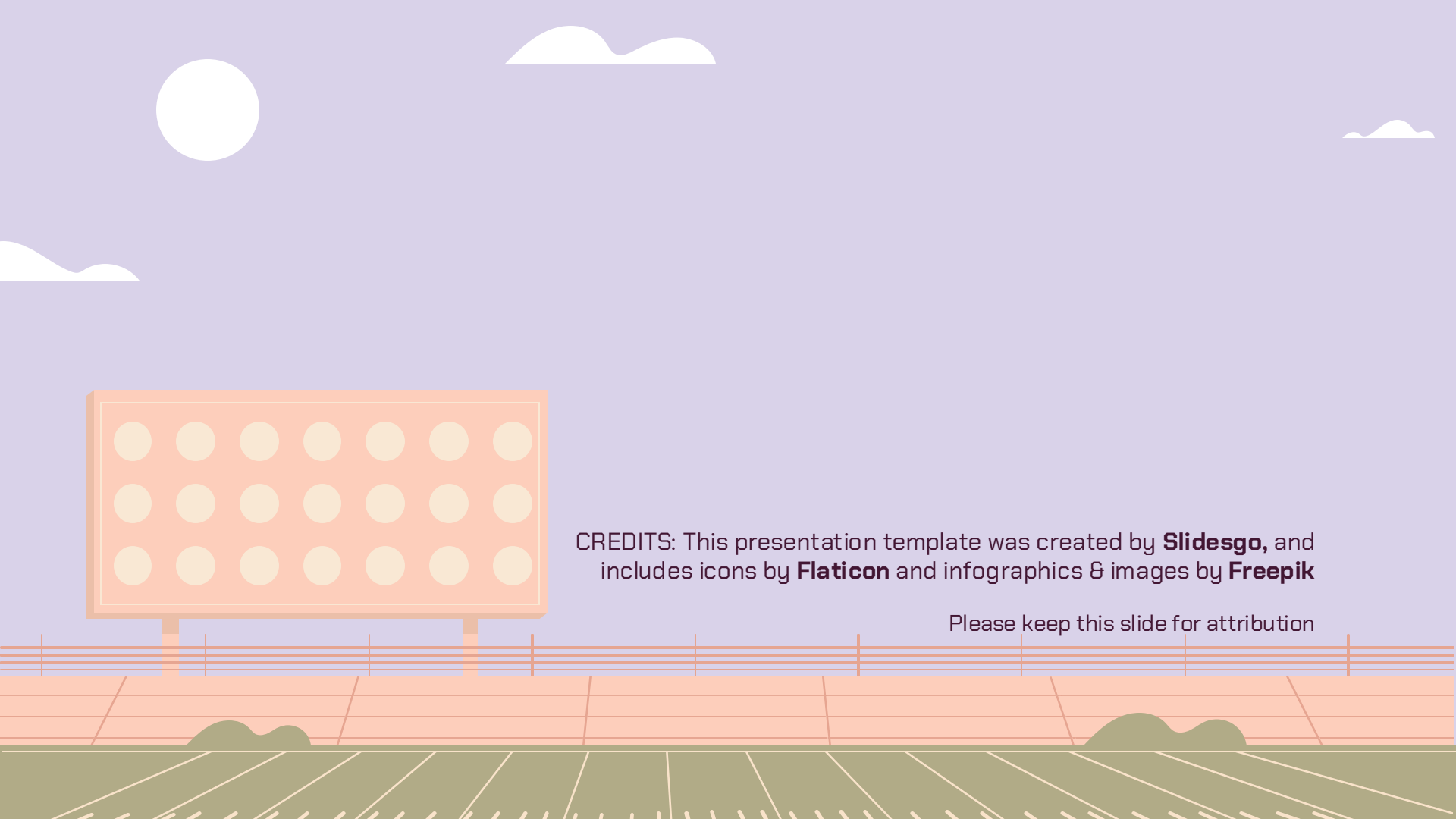
This crew of dedicated dads helps with one of the most iconic parts of game day—the inflatable Falcon run-through tunnel!
