LA-6 STATE POLICY #02 MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: CVMA® LA 6 High Mileage Riding Fund Raiser Program

1) GET OUT AND BE SEEN, NOT LOOKED FOR. This is the goal behind the program. Unlike the LRRP program, all miles ridden will count, not just CVMA® events. The program will run from 1 January to 31 December of each year. The program is open to all classes in the CVMA® (FM, SUP, AUX). AUX must enter their own motorcycle to enter this program. The overall winner will be announced at the January State meeting and will be given a plaque. The other members competing can purchase a High Mileage Patch and Tab indicating the mileage ridden. The mileage will be listed in 5,000 mile increments. For example; + 5,000, +10,000, +20,000, and so on (you road 7,513 miles you will be authorized the 5,000 mile tab). The entry for this state fund raiser program will be a \$10.00 donation, which will be to pay for the plaque to the overall winner and to help fund the state events. The individual patches (Attachment 3) will be an additional \$7.00 for the patch and \$3.00 for the year tab (Attachment 4). This is for contestants that wish to have this achievement for their vest.

2) Rules

a) One bike per entry, we will not be adding up miles from multiple bikes.

1. If you own multiple motorcycles, you may enter each motorcycle as its own entry. At the end of the year, the bike with the most miles will be considered for the award. You will need to submit a gas receipt for each bike, with miles written on the receipt and a photo of the receipt next to the odometer.

2. See paragraph 3 for an exception to this rule if a new bike is purchased during the year.

b) On or after 1 January, send a photo of a fuel receipt, to include your current mileage written on the receipt, next to the odometer of the motorcycle as a starting mileage (See attachment 1). This information will be sent to the state treasure by email to cvmala6statetres@gmail.com. In the email, include your first and last name, road name, member number, and chapter assignment. Starting miles must be received within 10 days of the receipt date. You can enter his program anytime throughout the year.

c) The \$10 fee will be sent to the state PayPal (or current pay site) within 10 days of the date of fuel receipt. Only the state treasure can make exceptions to this 10-day rule.

d) On or prior to 31 December, send a photo of a fuel receipt, to include the ending mileage written on the receipt, next to the odometer of the motorcycle as the ending mileage for the program (See attachment 2). This information will be sent to the state treasure by email to cvmala6statetres@gmail.com on or before 31 December. In the email, include your first and last name, road name, member number, and chapter assignment. **No submissions will be accepted after 31 December.** Email will have a date and time stamp associated with it.

3) Exception to rule 2A.

A. If a new bike is purchased during the year and you wish to include the miles the following must be met:

1. Old (Original) Motorcycle send a photo of a fuel receipt, to include the ending mileage written on the receipt, next to the odometer of the motorcycle as the ending mileage for this motorcycle.
2. New Motorcycle, send a photo of a fuel receipt, to include your current mileage written on the receipt, next to the odometer of the motorcycle as a starting mileage for new motorcycle
 - a. New motorcycle is new to you, brand new or used.
 - b. Your new motorcycle start date cannot be before the ending date of your old motorcycle.
3. On or prior to 31 December, send a photo of a fuel receipt, to include the ending mileage written on the receipt, next to the odometer of the new motorcycle as the ending mileage for the program

4) Traveling Trophy. A traveling trophy will be awarded to the chapter that has ridden the most miles for this program. For miles to count, chapter members must be enrolled into this program and follow the procedures.

5) One (1) order will be placed for patches and tabs. All members that competed and wish a patch and or tab will be required to pay for these items by 1 February. Payment will be accepted through normal State payment procedures.

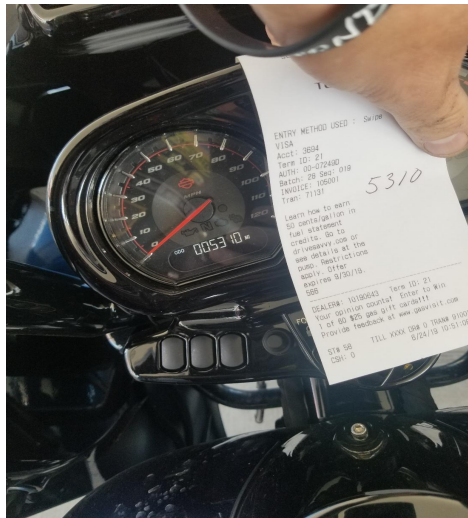
6) The LA 6 State Treasure is the point of contact for this program policy. Any questions regarding this policy will be directed through the chain of command.
