PROGRESS REPORT

2024 Highlights

- **Wetlands Thrive Life Survives:** Renewed RSPB grant to protect the Central Mangrove Wetland by raising awareness of its ecological importance.
- **Pirate Cove Nature Park:** Secured a Darwin+ Local grant to create a community space with nature-based solutions and mangrove restoration.
- **OnePlanet Partnership:** Joined the OnePlanet Community Partnership to enhance our impact on sustainable development.
- **UK Parliamentary Discussion:** Participated in a House of Commons discussion on regenerative culture and climate solutions.
- **Media Engagement:** Featured on Radio Scotland, Radio Cayman and ClimateGenn podcast to promote climate action.
- **Published Reports:** Released a comprehensive Transport Review Report and an Alternative Route Assessment Report for the East-West Arterial EIA, contributing to informed decision-making on transportation infrastructure.
- **Advocacy:** Sent an Open Letter to UK and Cayman Parliamentarians advocating for sustainable development.
- **Award Recognition:** Our Sustainability Campaign Officer won the Making Waves Award for environmental advocacy.

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Completed Projects 2023-2024

- “Rising Tides Departing Shores”: Delivered a collaborative discussion brief with OnePlanet.com to the House of Commons, emphasizing strategic migration management in response to climate change.
- Professional Development: An Ambassador obtained a Professional Certificate in Strategic Migration Management, enhancing our team’s expertise.
- Campaign Support: Secured a fixed-term contract for a Campaign Support Officer to strengthen our outreach efforts.
- Public Engagement: Actively engaged the public and gathered detailed feedback on PlanCayman, Affordable Housing Policy, and the Cargo Port OBC, ensuring community voices are heard.
- Sustainability Initiatives: Installed a solar air-conditioner at our office and hosted an Earth Month Sustainability Challenge to promote green practices.

- “Islands Echoes” Podcast: Hosted by Ambassadors, this podcast continues to highlight key environmental issues and solutions relevant to island communities.
