## **INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS**

For the 2026-2027 Academic Year, Panhellenic Association of San Antonio will grant two \$2,000 scholarships to two initiated NPC members attending a four-year college or university. Those attending a university or college in Texas shall be given preference. The scholarship will be announced at the May 2, 2026 annual Scholarship Luncheon, and the first \$1,000 checks will be awarded August 1<sup>st</sup>.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Any initiated, active member of a National Panhellenic Conference member sorority with a cumulative GPA of 2.25 or better who is a graduate of a Bexar, Kendall, Comal, Wilson, Guadalupe, Bandera, Atacosa or Medina County high school shall be eligible. All applicants must have been initiated prior to application submission. Selection will be based upon college academic record, sorority involvement, college campus and community activities, candidate's essay, financial needs, and recommendations submitted.

**No high school grades or activities will be considered.**

## **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

A completed application includes the following:

- The completed scholarship application form
- One letter of recommendation from a person who can attest to your sorority, campus, and/or community activities
- Collegiate resume
- An essay not to exceed 500 words on the impact your sorority membership has had on your academic performance and the value that your sorority involvement has added to your undergraduate education
- Transcript(s) of all university academic work. An unofficial copy is sufficient during the application process; the winner will be required to provide an official transcript by August 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **SCHOLARSHIP STIPULATIONS**

- The recipient must need a consecutive Fall and Spring semester to graduate.
- The recipient must be enrolled full time (12 hours minimum) per semester of scholarship receipt and be working towards completion of a degree. **Fall 2026 Semester GPA must be at least 3.0 to receive the Spring semester disbursement.**
- The scholarship of \$1,000 sent per semester will be mailed directly to the recipient.

## **RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT**

- Submit to the Scholarship Chairman a copy of your official university cumulative grade report including the immediate past semester **AND** a copy of your university bill (statement of registration fees) for the Fall 2026 semester. Scholarship award will then be mailed directly to the recipient. Every effort will be made for the check to be sent prior to the fall semester, but this cannot be guaranteed.
- Submit to the Scholarship Chairman a copy of your official university cumulative grade report including the Fall 2026 semester **AND** a copy of your Spring 2027 university bill (statement of registration fees). Scholarship award will then be mailed directly to the recipient. Every effort will be made for the check to be sent prior to the spring semester, if GPA requirements are satisfied
