


Admissions Policy







CLIQUE Admissions Procedure 2025-26

Issue and Review

The date of issue of this policy is September 2022.

This policy was reviewed and updated August 2025.

This policy will continue to be reviewed annually.

Please ensure you have read these notes prior to applying to any of our courses and retain them for your reference.

1. Applications

- **Application Submission**: You can apply online at www.cliquecollege.com. Your application must be completed and submitted by the advertised deadline.
- No Application Fee: Applying to our courses is free.
- Application Acknowledgment: Upon processing your application, we will acknowledge receipt and contact you to schedule an audition date. While we strive to provide ample notice, some auditions may be arranged at short notice, so please be prepared before submitting your application.

2. Auditions

All candidates must audition to be considered for a place at CLIQUE College. During the audition, candidates may be assessed on the following criteria, where applicable:

- Initial impression/presentation
- Understanding of the profession/industry
- Openness to learning
- Ability to discuss and focus on questions
- Standard of work in audition
- Level of maturity shown
- Ability to contribute to the audition day

Audition Components:

- **Group Workshops**: Candidates will likely participate in Ballet, Commercial/Hip Hop, and Technical Jazz workshops.
- Individual Audition: Candidates must prepare:
 - A solo dance piece (up to 60 seconds)
 - A 60-second singing solo of their choice

Candidates must bring their music and backing tracks on a Bluetooth-enabled device. Please note that we cannot provide assistance if you forget your music, so ensure you are prepared.

• **Individual Interview**: An individual interview will be conducted, which parents and guardians are welcome to attend.

Candidates need to demonstrate their suitability for intense vocational training.

3. Post-Audition Process

After an audition, candidates will receive one of the following:

- a) Offer Letter: Successful candidates will receive an offer letter for the course they have applied to.
- b) **Holding Letter**: Candidates may be placed on hold while other candidates are interviewed. This may be followed by an offer letter, a waiting list letter, or an unsuccessful application letter. Please note that a holding letter can sometimes remain in process for several months until all interviews have been completed.
- c) **Unsuccessful Application Letter**: Candidates who have not gained a place on the course will be informed.
- d) **Waiting List Letter**: Candidates who would be eligible for a place if another chosen candidate withdraws will be placed on a waiting list.

Important Notes:

- A holding letter does not mean you are not wanted on the course; it simply indicates that the audition/interview round is still in progress.
- As a matter of principle, CLIQUE College will not audition or interview a candidate for whom there is not a place available.
- Offer Acceptance: Successful auditionees must accept their offer by the date specified in the offer letter. To secure their place, they must also pay a non-refundable acceptance fee of £125.00.

4. Limited Places for 2026 Entry

As CLIQUE College continues to grow at a rapid pace, places for 2025 entry will be extremely limited. We strongly encourage prospective students to submit their applications and attend auditions as early as possible to maximize their chances of securing a place.

5. Additional Information

- Panel Decision: The decision of the panel is final.
- One Application Per Year: You may apply only once per academic year.

6. Guidance for Applicants with a Disability

CLIQUE College welcomes applications from students with disabilities, including dyslexia, dyspraxia, and other specific learning difficulties. Our admissions decisions are based solely on the audition/interview process.

Declaring a Disability:

CLIQUE College is committed to supporting disabled students. We encourage you to declare any disability so that appropriate support can be arranged as soon as possible. This may include adjustments during the audition/interview process, such as extra time or modified schedules.

During Audition/Interview:

A CLIQUE team member will be available to assist you upon arrival.

- If you are nervous or need accommodations, please let us know, and we will do our best to help.
- It's fine to ask the panel to repeat any question.

Physical Requirements:

Please note that our courses are very physical. Most auditions will include warm-ups and activities that may involve eye contact and/or physical contact, and adjustments to this may not always be possible.
