BEFORE YOU BOOK

Start with the Right Answers

These are the most common questions first-time cruisers ask before booking their dream vacation.



1. BALCONY VS INTERIOR CABIN

Balconies offer views, fresh air, and extra space. Interior cabins are budget-friendly and perfect if you plan to spend less time in your room.

◆ *Tip: Match your cabin to YOUR travel style and budget.*



2. BEST CABIN LOCATION

Midship, on lower decks, is best for less movement. Avoid cabins near elevators, nightclubs, pools, or high-traffic areas.

◆ *Tip: Location can impact your comfort and sleep.*



3. DO I NEED A PASSPORT?

Some sailings allow a birth certificate and ID, but a passport is strongly recommended in case of emergencies.

◆ *Tip: A passport gives you more flexibility and peace of mind.*



4. WILL I GET SEASICK?

Most people don't! Newer ships have stabilizers that reduce movement. Choose a midship, lower deck cabin for the smoothest ride.

◆ *Tip: Pack remedies just in case—better safe than sorry!*



5. WHAT CRUISE LINE IS BEST FOR ME?

It depends on your travel style, budget, destination, and who you're traveling with. Families, couples, and solo travelers all have great options!

◆ *Tip: I can help you find the perfect match.*

BEFORE YOU PACK

Pack Smart, Cruise Happy

A little preparation goes a long way! Here are the key things first-time cruisers want to know before they pack.



1. CAN I BRING SNACKS?

Yes! Most cruise lines allow sealed, pre-packaged snacks like granola bars, chips, cookies, and crackers. Avoid fresh fruit, homemade items, and anything that needs refrigeration.

◆ *Tip: Perfect for picky eaters and families with kids!*



2. HOW MUCH CASH SHOULD I BRING?

You'll use your cruise card for most things onboard, but cash is helpful for ports, taxis, souvenirs, and tips. Small bills are best.

◆ *Tip: \$100–\$200 in small bills is a good rule of thumb.*



3. WHAT DOCUMENTS DO I NEED?

A passport is strongly recommended. Some sailings allow a birth certificate and ID, but a passport offers the most flexibility and peace of mind.

◆ *Tip: Don't forget travel insurance and any required visas.*



4. WHAT SHOULD I PACK?

EMBARKATION DAY

Your Cruise Starts Here

Everything you need to know about boarding day so your vacation begins stress-free.



1. HOW EARLY SHOULD I ARRIVE?

Cruise lines assign arrival times during online check-in. Arriving too early may mean waiting outside the terminal, while arriving late can add unnecessary stress.

◆ *Tip: Plan to arrive within your assigned arrival window.*



2. WHAT SHOULD I CARRY ON?

Never place these items in checked luggage:

- ✓ Passport or travel documents
- ✓ Medications
- ✓ Wallet and identification
- ✓ Phone charger
- ✓ Swimsuit
- ✓ Change of clothes
- ✓ Cruise paperwork
- ✓ Sunscreen

◆ *Tip: Checked luggage may not arrive at your cabin for several hours.*



3. CAN I ACCESS MY CABIN IMMEDIATELY?

Usually not. Cabins are being cleaned and prepared while guests board. Most cruise lines announce when staterooms are ready.

Until then, enjoy lunch, explore the ship, or attend activities.

◆ *Tip: Pack your swimsuit in your carry-on if you want to enjoy the pool right away.*



4. WHAT SHOULD I DO FIRST?

Most first-time cruisers head directly to the buffet. Instead:

- ✓ Explore the ship
- ✓ Find your cabin location
- ✓ Download the cruise app
- ✓ Check entertainment schedules
- ✓ Review dining reservations
- ✓ Locate your muster station

◆ *Tip: The more familiar you are with the ship, the smoother your vacation will be.*



5. HOW DOES BOARDING WORK?

The process is simpler than many people expect:

1. Arrive at the terminal
2. Present travel documents
3. Pass through security screening
4. Receive your cruise card or activate your mobile key
5. Board the ship

Then your vacation officially begins!

◆ *Tip: Complete online check-in before arrival to speed up boarding.*

ONBOARD LIFE

*What's Included, What's Extra,
and How to Make the Most of Your Cruise*

Understanding what's included, what costs extra, and how to plan ahead helps you enjoy more and stress less.



1. WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Most cruise fares include:

- ✓ Your cabin
- ✓ Meals in main dining room & buffet
- ✓ Entertainment & activities
- ✓ Kids' clubs
- ✓ Fitness center
- ✓ Shows & live music

◆ *Tip: Read your cruise line's website to see exactly what's included in your fare.*



2. ARE DRINK PACKAGES WORTH IT?

It depends on how much (and what) you drink. Do the math before you buy. Most cruise lines let you purchase packages before boarding—often at a discount.

◆ *Tip: Alcohol packages typically aren't worth it for light drinkers.*



3. IS WI-FI WORTH IT?

Wi-Fi is usually an extra cost and can be slow, especially in busy areas. It's great for messaging and email, but streaming isn't ideal.

◆ *Tip: Download shows, movies, and playlists before your cruise.*



4. HOW DO GRATUITIES WORK?

Most cruise lines automatically add gratuities to your onboard account. You can usually adjust the amount at Guest Services if needed.

◆ *Tip: Gratuities cover your stateroom attendant, dining staff, and other crew members.*



5. CAN I DRINK THE WATER?

Yes! The tap water on cruise ships is safe to drink. You can bring a refillable bottle and use water stations around the ship.

◆ *Tip: Save money and stay hydrated!*



EXTRA COSTS TO KNOW



Specialty dining

Steakhouses, sushi, and specialty restaurants have an extra charge.



Spa & salon services

Massages, facials, and salon treatments are not included.



Photos & souvenirs

Professional photos and gift shop items cost extra.



Shore excursions

Excursions at ports of call are an additional cost.



Casino & some activities

Casino charges and select activities may have fees.

Plan ahead. Budget smart. Enjoy more.

PORT DAYS & SHORE EXCURSIONS

Making the Most of Every Destination

1. SHOULD I BOOK AN EXCURSION?

Excursions are a great way to experience your destination without the stress of planning every detail yourself.

Popular options include:

- ✓ Snorkeling
- ✓ Beach clubs
- ✓ Wildlife encounters
- ✓ Cultural tours
- ✓ Catamaran cruises
- ✓ Adventure activities

◆ *Tip: Popular excursions often sell out before sailing.*

2. CRUISE LINE OR INDEPENDENT EXCURSION?

Both options can be great.

CRUISE LINE EXCURSIONS

- ✓ Easy booking
- ✓ Ship knows where you are
- ✓ Added peace of mind

INDEPENDENT EXCURSIONS

- ✓ Often less expensive
- ✓ Smaller group sizes
- ✓ More flexibility

◆ *Tip: Research carefully before booking independently.*

3. WHAT IF I'M LATE RETURNING TO THE SHIP?

This is every cruiser's biggest fear.

If you're on a cruise line-sponsored excursion, the ship typically works with the tour operator if delays occur. If you're exploring independently, it's your responsibility to return before all-aboard time.

◆ *Tip: Always plan to return well before the deadline.*

4. HOW MUCH CASH SHOULD I BRING ASHORE?

Many destinations accept credit cards, but cash is still helpful for:

- ✓ Taxis
- ✓ Local vendors
- ✓ Small purchases
- ✓ Tips
- ✓ Emergency expenses

◆ *Tip: Bring small bills and avoid carrying large amounts of cash.*

5. CAN I STAY ON THE SHIP?

Absolutely! Many experienced cruisers enjoy port days onboard. Benefits include:

- ✓ Smaller crowds
- ✓ Easier access to pools
- ✓ Shorter food lines
- ✓ Relaxing atmosphere
- ✓ Great spa specials

1. WHAT'S INCLUDED?

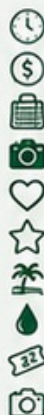
