

## ITEMS YOU NEED TO BRING

- Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, towels, shower shoes, etc
- Towels, hangars, washcloths, pillow, sleeping bag and/or sheets & blankets.
- Clothing suitable for recreation (swim, play) and services.  
Shirts and shorts must be worn in the lake! (see "Camp rules procedures")
- Sweater or jacket for evening and mornings (It does get cold in the evenings)
- Money for snack shack. (Junior High and Senior campers need money for Lunch, about \$10-20 per day depending how much you eat)
- It is recommended that the Camper's name be marked on all clothing.
- Bible, notebook, and a pen!
- Spending money (Paintball, Snack Shack, Camp Store, Camp Shirt).
