The East Midlands SEND Training Hub is an integral part of Brackenfield Special School and has been created to support and formalise our outreach work to schools, both mainstream and special, within our community. The East Midlands SEND Training Hub exists to support outcomes for all pupils with SEND; both within a local area and further afield. For this reason, training is affordable, high quality and targeted towards specific areas.

<u>School to School Support</u> is an important part of the EMSTH. Support is bespoke to each setting and takes many forms including visits both to us and to other settings, virtual meetings, providing support with resources and interventions and whole school or specific pupil input. There is also the option to purchase our two inhouse resources – <u>Journey to Learn</u> and the <u>B Level Assessment Grids</u>.
