91-10 members – Club President, or her alternate and 10 additional delegates;

101- and more members – Club President, or her alternate and 11 additional delegates;

Join park rangers as they teach you about the night sky, observe the Perseids meteor shower, and discuss the effects of light pollution. Meet the rangers at the Skyline Trail parking lot and either take a relaxing wagon ride or walk our beautiful trail up to Jefferson Point. Be sure to bring something comfortable to sit on and a red light flashlight if you have one.
