

GFWC Virginia Reports, Award Selection and Annual Reports Instructions for State Chairmen

State Reports to GFWC must be mailed by March 15. After that, your next step is to select your winners.

When selecting your winners, don't see just hours and dollars, consider the resources available and how the resources were used.

Judging Best Single Project

1. Did the club meet one of the objectives?
2. How many of the members involved?
3. Was the participation active or passive (self educating or donating money)?
4. What was the impact on the community?

Judging Best Overall

1. What was the overall impact on the community
2. Did the club meet all, or most, of the objectives?
3. Were most of the members involved?
4. Was the participation active or passive (self educating or donating money)?

Club reports are judged according to size. Categories for 2024 reports:

Generals Clubs

Small: 1-25 members; Large: 26 members and over.

Junior Clubs

Small: 1-12 members; Large: 13 members and over.

*The spreadsheet of the official club size will be emailed to you. **Do not** use the number of members in the club reports.*

Award Categories

We are changing things up for the 2024 reporting year – ALL AREAS will have the same categories!

Preparing your Annual Report for publication in the GFWC Virginia Annual Report:

Your award winners and a brief report from each Chairman will be published as a part of the GFWC Virginia Annual Report that will be distributed at Convention. Heather will compile the Annual Report. Please email this information by March 20th (before this date if at all possible) to Heather at Headquarters (gfwcvirginia@verizon.net) and cc to Cynthia (firstvp@gfwcvirginia.org) and Lynn (assistjrdirector@gfwcvirginia.org).

Your department or program, including the award winners, **must** fit on one half of a page. These reports are bound as part of the permanent record, so please allow the recommended side margin of .63 and use the following format:

DEPARTMENT NAME (Bold, all caps, 12 font, Times New Roman or similar)

Your name (s), Chairman (12 font)

(12 font) include the statistical totals: # projects, # hours, # members, \$. Describe the major areas of interest and impact. In 3-4 sentences summarize the work of the GFWC Virginia clubs.

Follow your brief statement with the list of your winners, using the following format. What you write for Best Overall is what will be read out loud at Convention:

Best Single Project – Small Club – General – Your Favorite Club – Winning District

Describe project, no more than 3 lines

Best Single Project – Small Club – Junior – Your Favorite Club – Winning District

Describe project, no more than 3 lines

Best Single Project – Large Club – General – Your Favorite Club – Winning District

Describe project, no more than 3 lines

Best Single Project – Large Club – Junior – Your Favorite Club – Winning District

Describe project, no more than 3 lines

Best Overall – Small Club – Your Favorite Club – Winning District

Describe projects, no more than 3 lines.

Best Overall – Large Club – Your Favorite Club – Winning District

Describe projects, no more than 3 lines.

Affiliate Awards

An award will be presented for each Affiliate area as determined by the GFWC Virginia President. As State Chairmen you may be contacted by the State President for supporting documentation, if more information is needed than what clubs provided on the Affiliate form they sent to the State President.

Presentation of Awards at Convention

Certificates will be handed out at the end of Convention as a group to each club. Cynthia & Lynn will announce the winners in the appropriate size categories. Pictures will be taken with Susie and Joanne at the end of each session.
