

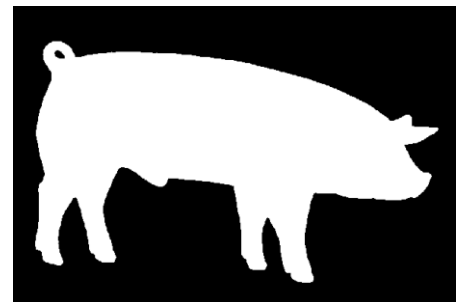

ADOPTED 9/8/93 BY THE LIVESTOCK TASK FORCE


1. Exhibitors must be present to exhibit their own animals.
2. All animals must be accompanied to and at the shows by the exhibitor, parent or a designated responsible party.
3. All monies owed must be paid before premium checks will be delivered.
4. A \$5.00 fee per exhibitor will be collected at entry night to help defray miscellaneous costs. (Example - mailing entries, entry shipping and handling, equipment, signs, etc.)

Policy & Procedures for 4-H Member Absences and Eligibility from School

Parents and 4-H'er Information

Agreement has been reached with all Lubbock County public schools on policy and procedures pertaining to 4-H absences and eligibility applying to the current Texas Education Code "No Pass - No Play" requirements. Provisions of the agreement include:

- 1) At the time of a 4-H'ers entry/application/qualification for any competitive event that would require school absence(s), the 4-H'ers and/or family will **INDICATE THE SHOW(S) TO BE ATTENDED BY COMPLETING THE School Absence Request Form**
- 2) At the above "entry" time 4-H families will be provided current details on procedures to follow. The following procedures will enhance the cooperation among schools and 4-H. Please review and take action.

PARENTS:

- a. Notify your 4-H'ers' school principal **OF THE EXACT DATES OF UPCOMING SCHOOL ABSENCES** and determine the steps needed to make the absences(s) flow smoothly.
 - b. make sure that you understand the school district's policy for the 10 day / 90% attendance requirements and consequences if the rules are abused.
 - c. visit with school instructors to see what plans can be made concerning homework, tests, projects, etc., that will be missed during the absence.
 - d. make sure that your 4-H'er is passing all subjects prior to and during the absence period.
- 3) Two weeks (14 days) prior to an event requiring school absence(s), the Lubbock County Extension Office will email or fax a letter to school principals requesting certification of eligibility of students and an approved absence(s). No response from the school(s) will indicate such identified students (4-H'ers) to be eligible and approved for school absence. **We will list the dates of the show - IT IS UP TO YOU to let your school know the exact dates you will miss.**
 - 4) If a 4-H member is not eligible to be excused or is ineligible for 4-H events, the 4-H office will notify the 4-H member, their parents and sponsoring agency of the situation by letter.
 - 5) Non-compliance or violations by 4-H members shall be penalized by the school district's policy/Discipline Management System. Individual violations may jeopardize Lubbock County 4-H's eligibility as an approved extra-curricular activity at the school(s). This can hurt all 4-H'ers and cause concern in all school districts.
