  - Applicant must have shown a project at the Lubbock County Junior Livestock Show for at least 3 years (the current show season can be included) and this participation must be able to be verified.
  - If applying for the Ag Mechanics Scholarship, the participant must have shown an Ag Mechanic project the last year and this year
  - Must be a High School Senior and expected to graduate in the spring of the award year.
  - Plan to enroll in a college, university, or trade school for the fall semester following high school graduation.
