- Lubbock County Junior Livestock Show, P.O. Box 62, Idalou, TX 7929
- Applicant, including Ag Mech must have shown a project at the Lubbock County Junior Livestock Show for at least 3 years (the current show season can be included) and this participation must be able to be verified.
- Must be a High School Senior and expected to graduate in the spring of the award year.
- Plan to enroll in a college, university, or trade school for the fall semester following high school graduation.
- Must be present at the LCJLSA Premium Auction on January 23, 2026.
