Gender Inequity in Modern Britain About

Business Leadership

- In 2013, British men were almost twice as likely to be a manager, director or senior official than women (EHRC)
- In 2020, there were more male CEOs called Peter in the UK than female CEOs overall (Durham)
- Women make up only 6% of CEOs of FTSE 100 companies. None of these 6% are women of colour (LSE)

Politics and Economics

- Only 40% of MPs in 2024 were women
- The gender pay gap in Britain is still 11.3% (Fawcett Society)
- Women of colour are less likely to be employed than White British women, and consistently earn less per hour than White British men (Fawcett Society)

Home Life

- 85% of women cook or do housework every day compared with just 49% of men (LSE)
- Mothers spend more time on childcare than fathers. on average (UK Gov't)
- Women are more likely than men to be victims of domestic violence or abuse (EHRC)


