



THE BIGGEST CHALLENGE FOR EVERY PROJECT IS THE ABILITY TO MANAGE THE BUDGET WHILE MAINTAINING THE SCHEDULE AND THE QUALITY OF WORK INSTALLED IN A SAFE MANNER

These two projects that have been high-lighted are great examples of successfully maintaining the budget and the owners expectations while under a highly dynamic "scope-change" atmosphere.

EELV - Atlas V for Launch Complex 41: Base Contract = \$89,000,000 Final Contract = \$280,054,170 (214% increase)

Fun Facts: This program was a prototype project (one of a kind) exploring a new concept in launching heavy lift vehicles with a "clean pad" approach. The base GMP was converted to Design-Build GMP. I then converted all major subcontractors from Lump Sum contracts to Design-Assist/GMP (with incentive fee) contracts to provide transparency and control over scope changes. Close to \$12M was returned to the owner after the project completed on time. Lockheed was so pleased with the performance the Atlas V SLC 3 project on the West Coast was awarded as sole-source.

Fun Facts: This 4.7M sf renovation included the addition of a unified command center, as well as all of the force protection and cyber security measures mandated by the events on 9/11. The program included maintaining operations for twenty thousand employees and accelerating the schedule by more than two years to overcome impacts from 9/11. The Design-Build GMP contract with 100% award fee stayed intact, allowing full visibility of costs for the client. A conversion from Lump Sum to GMP of all major subcontractors and design partners was implemented by me to assure control and transparency for over 90% of the work completed. Close to \$90M was returned to the owner
