➤ Coaches must have a Red Passbook with the 2026 membership card and have been certified within the last 24 months.
➤ Bring all boxer books to the meeting
➤ Completed Team Rosters
➤ Completed Golden Gloves 2026 Boxer entry forms
➤ Elite & Senior Novice Tournament Weigh In and confirmation of match bout pairings Peewee, Bantam, Intermediate Jr and Youth are not required to weigh in February 15, 2026

All Athletes must have:

- ✓ 2026 Golden Gloves Tournament entry form signed by the participant. The entry form must be signed by their parents or guardians for all participants under the age of 18 and turned in at the Coaches Meeting.
- ✓ And a current USA Boxing issued passbook.

All Coaches must have

A current USA Boxing Red Passbook with a 2025 registration label and have proof of attending a current certification clinic & Safe Sport Training.

Each team will receive the amount of coach's passes based on the following:

1-7 boxers = 2 passes

7 + boxers =3 passes

Credentials will be given during the coaches meeting.

- ❖ An update will be provided at the meeting on the number of Elite Boxers participating in the tournament as well as the matched-up bouts.
- ❖ When submitting a team roster, coaches are encouraged to provide information on any bouts that have been agreed upon as a bout match.
- ❖ This year, Golden Gloves Tournament participants will be given wrist bands to enter the venue. A different color for each day of the tournament.

Advancing Division (Male and Female)

Elite Division – 5+ bouts – 3 rounds at 3 minutes: *All boxers must have at least 10 bouts in their book to compete at the State Golden Gloves. (Division Champions qualify for participation in the State Golden Gloves Tournament)*

Senior Elite Novice division less than 5 bouts - 3 rounds at 1 minute -Additional allowed minutes per round are negotiable.

Weight Divisions for all Golden Gloves Competition:

MEN: 110 LBS; 121 LBS; 132 LBS; 143 LBS; 154 LBS; 165 LBS.

176 LBS; 187 LBS; 198 LBS; 198+ LBS

WOMEN: 106 LBS; 112 LBS; 119 LBS; 125 LBS; 132 LBS; 143 LBS.

154 LBS; 165 LBS; 176 LBS; 176+ LBS

Matched Bout Divisions (Male and Female)

Peewee, Bantam, Intermediate, Junior & Youth

Refer to USA Boxing Rulebook Appendix F for weight classifications.

3 rounds @ 1minute – Additional allowed minutes per round are negotiable.

Point Allocation to determine Team Trophy Elite Competition

2 Points -Winner of each Elite Weight division bout

1 Points- Runner-up of each Elite Weight division

Point Allocation to determine Team Trophy Non-Elite Division Competition

1 Point-Winner of each boxing bout
