The 1930s

The 1934 yearbook listed the following individuals as FFA officers: President, Glenn Smith; vice-president, Tom Greenfield; secretary, Edgar Moore; treasurer, Charles Edwards; reporter, Lyle Cook; and sponsor, J.V Langdon

The 1935 yearbook showed a picture of the "Future Farmer" members and noted that their main activities were "stock judging contests and the state FFA oratorical contest held in Tucson."



In 1937, the yearbook recorded that on "March 26 and 27, Lyle Cook, Herbert Perry, Edward Hauser, and Claude Stafford represented PHS in the State Judging Contest in Tucson. Herbert Perry returned with the honor of being the best Poultry Judge in Arizona. Edward Hauser received third place in judging Beef Cattle. The Peoria team tied Glendale for fifth place in Poultry Judging. Clyde McFrederick and Edward Hauser were representatives of the Peoria Chapter to the Annual Convention."
